

2.2.1. Making text to stand out

The emphasis mark-up serves the purpose through three of its attributes.

style	The selectable values, <i>italic</i> , bold and bolditalic , request <i>italic</i> , bold and simultaneously <i>bold and italic</i> font faces, respectively.
decoration	The three selectable values <u>underline</u> , <u>overline</u> and line-through result in the in-situ demonstrated effects.
frame	With the aid of this attribute borders can be drawn at the <u>top</u> , <u>bottom</u> , <u>topbot</u> (<u>top & bottom</u>) edges, at the <u>sides</u> (<u>sides</u>) as well as on <u>all edges</u> of the selected text A use of such framing has already occurred on <i>page</i> .

Moreover, if neither of the attributes are present the default style *italic* is assumed, while IF only style is missing the assumed font style is *normal*.

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
