Prayer Before Office

In the beginning, offer to God the praises that you are about to pour forth in his honour, and beseech him to free you from distractions, and to give you light and help to praise him and to pray to him as he deserves; and for this end recite attentively the usual prayer: (St. Alphonsus Liguori)

PEN my mouth, O Lord, that I may bless thy holy name. Cleanse my heart from all vain, evil and wandering thoughts; enlighten my understanding, enkindle my affections, that I may worthily recite this Office with attention and devotion, and may worthily be heard before the presence of thy Divine Maiesty. Through Christ our Lord. R/ Amen

O Lord, in union with that Divine Intention wherewith thou didst thyself praise God, while as thou wast on earth. I offer these Hours (or this Hour) unto thee.

UR Father, Who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation: but deliver us from evil. Amen.

AIL, Mary, full of grace; The Lord is with thee: blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen
