Word was configured to make hyperlinks relative by the following option: Tools – Options – General – Web Options – Files: check Update Links on Save.

Here's a link to <u>Child document 1</u>, another to <u>Child document 2</u> and finally one to Grandchild document 1.

Note: <u>Child Document 1</u> has a report from ARTS PDF Aerialist which shows the inner details of an example hyperlink.

These PDF files are handled properly by Acrobat Reader on Windows and Linux and by Foxit Reader on Windows. In other words, the linked PDF files open immediately in the PDF reader on clicking the hyperlinks.

Some PDF readers can follow the links, but insist on opening the linked PDF in the default web browser and adding insult to injury, give a security warning first asking the user if she wants to open the linked file. I believe this is bad behavior for a PDF reader.

Some PDF readers, including those built on MuPDF fail to follow the links at all.
