This demos a bug where if this .odt file is converted to PDF, then copy-and-paste with the mouse of the following email address copies corrupted text:

`critters@example.com`

The copied text may have extra spaces between letters, or even dropped letters. I first found this when an email like the above was copy-and-pasted as “criterssexample.com”.

NOTE 1: The email was at one point auto-converted to a link, but later I did rightclick→remove link (in case that matters).

NOTE 2: This .odt file has been processed by non-LibreOffice software (the ODF::lpOD Perl library). So it may have constructs which are legal ODF but somewhat different than what LibreOffice generates.
