

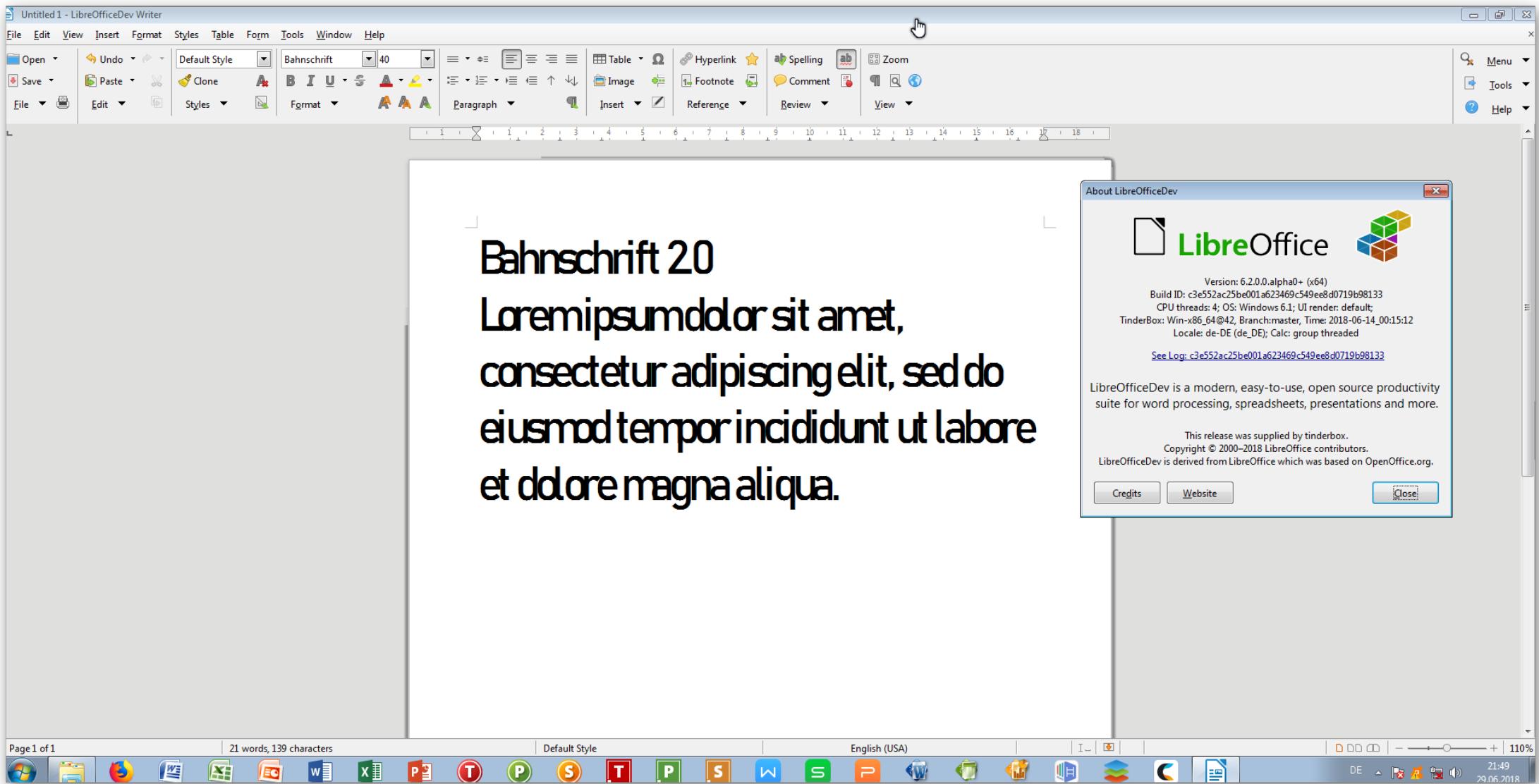
No kerning with new release of „Bahnschrift“ font (supplied with Win 10 by Microsoft)

LO does not support kerning of font „Bahnschrift“ 2.00. LO is affected of the kerning issue since 5.4. The old release 1.00 still works with the latest release of LO. Issue can be reproduced with Win 7.

(Microsoft supplied font „Bahnschrift“ 1.00 to all Win 10 systems with fall 2017 update. In following Win 10 update [May 2018], they released „Bahnschrift“ 2.00.)

Reproduction of issue:

1. Run Windows 10 (with May 2018 update)
2. Start Writer (LO 5.4 or later)
3. Choose font „Bahnschrift“
4. Type something



Kerning of Microsoft font „Bahnschrift“ does not work at all, since the font was updated to 2.0 with the May update of Windows 10. No issue with the 1.0 version of the font (released in fall 2017).

I tested both versions with Win 7 and the issue persists.

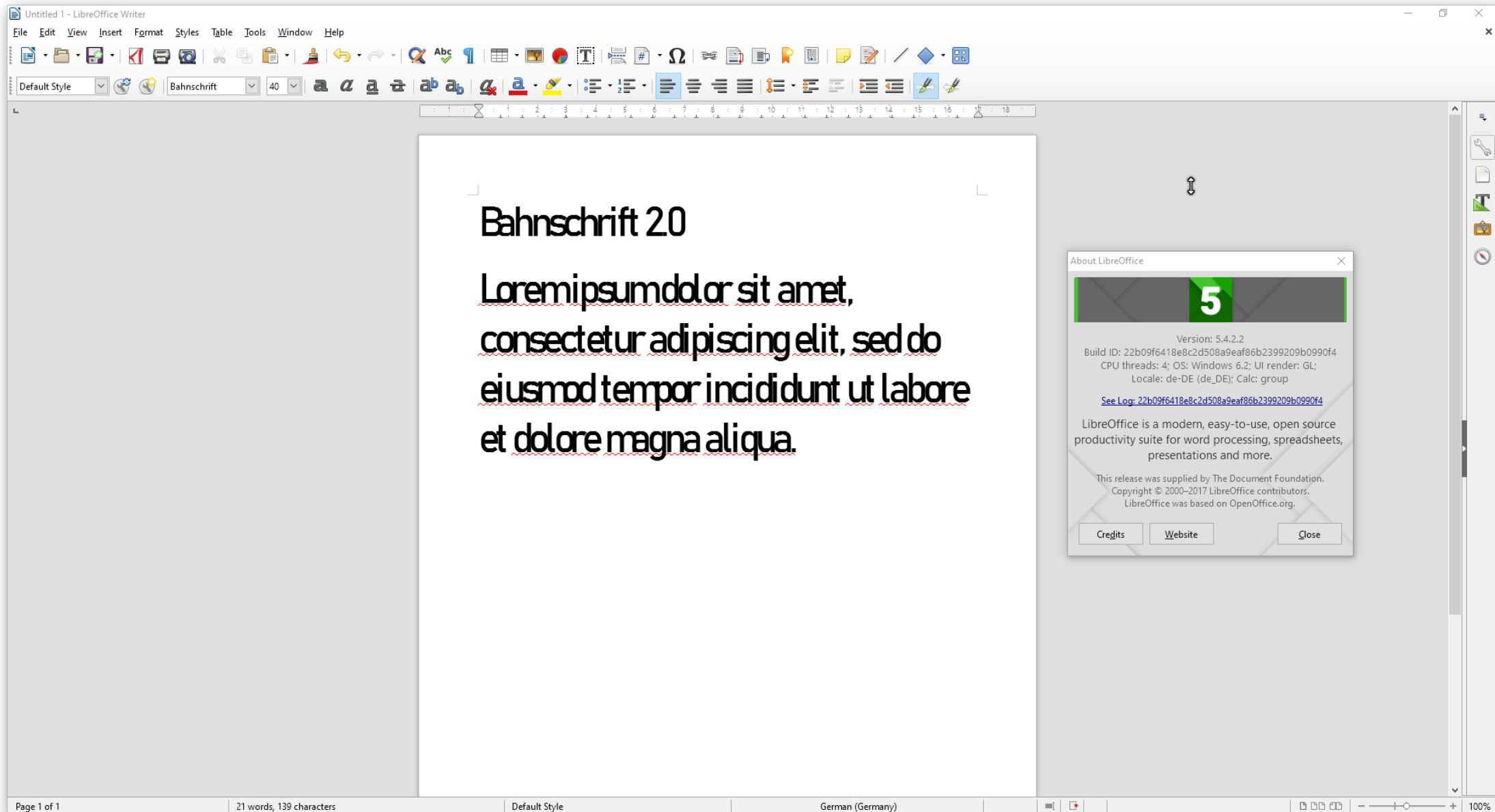

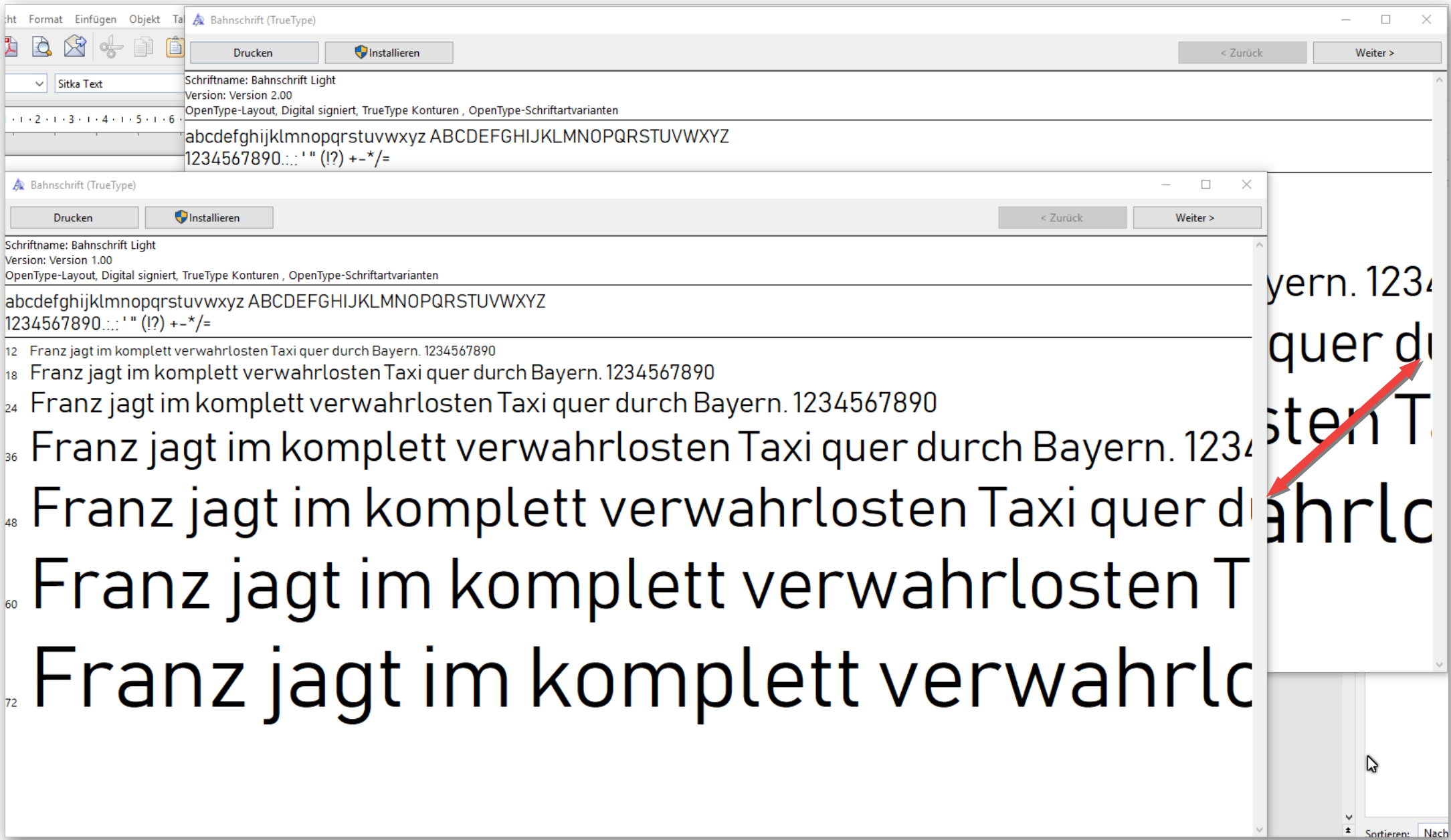
