



On the left you see a query. The code is a part of the code, which works with internal HSQldb.

If you start this query in Firebird it will give the error, which is shown in the warning.

When closing the dialog you could save the query, but the database isn't available any more. If I click on a table it will show the content of the second dialog - and no data. I have to close Firebird and reopen it for continue working.

This error won't appear if I set the code inside the brackets in a query and write down the date for "a"."Datum" from today. So it could be a problem interpreting correlated subqueries.

I would accept a query couldn't work, but never a query will shoot down the connection to the database.
