## Spellcheck context menu has too few variants.

To demonstrate problem I have used random French word, because French dictionary installed by default. Sorry if it means something wrong.

I have entered one word, then changed font property to French. Becomes this:
adore
Then I added two errors: twisted d and o and added n. Becomes this:
aodren
Then I right clicked on it. Becomes this:
aodren

Audrey

context menu for spell check becomes useless for us. If there would be more variants than we would find the word we need.
This function is fast and I can see no sense to reduce amount of variants so hard. If this context menu would be from top screen to bottom, users could be almost always find needed word.
On russian situation even worse. Spelcheck often can not find right variant if added one letter in end of word.

And here is another problem. If, for example, print this word:
sa
and right click, we see:
