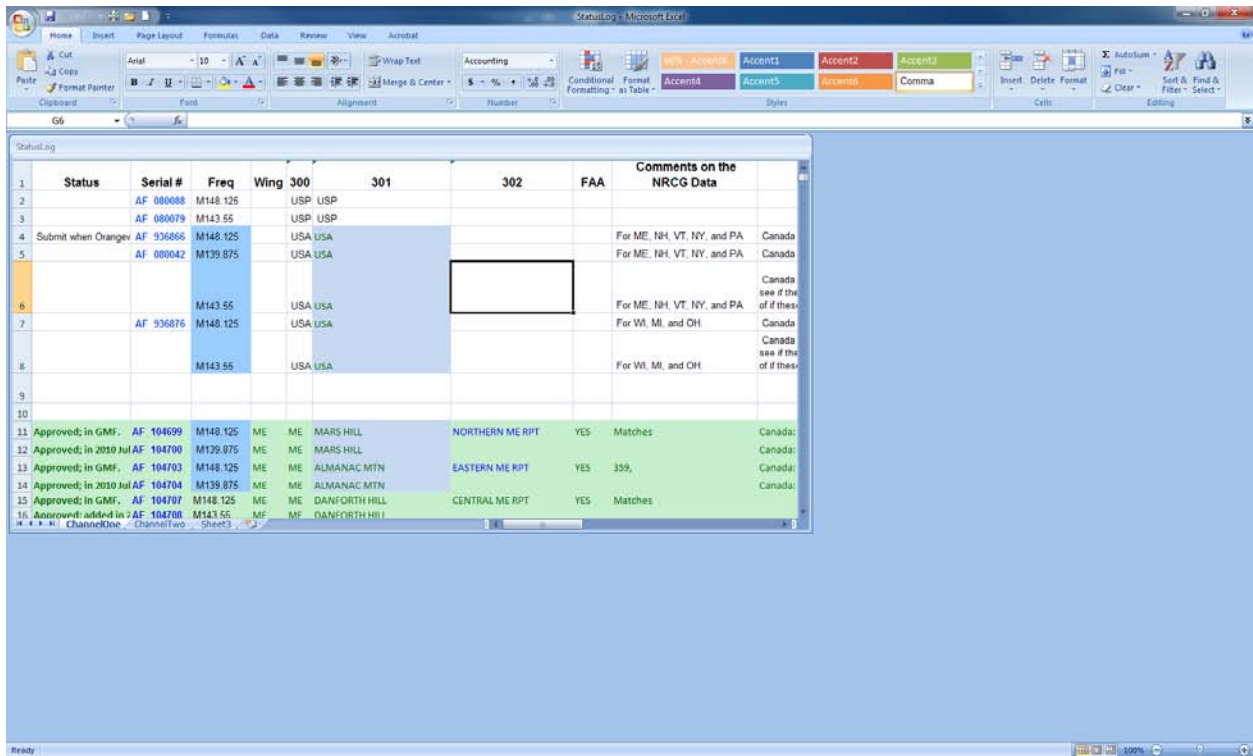




After using LibreOffice program, I ship it back to my office. This is how it appears:
