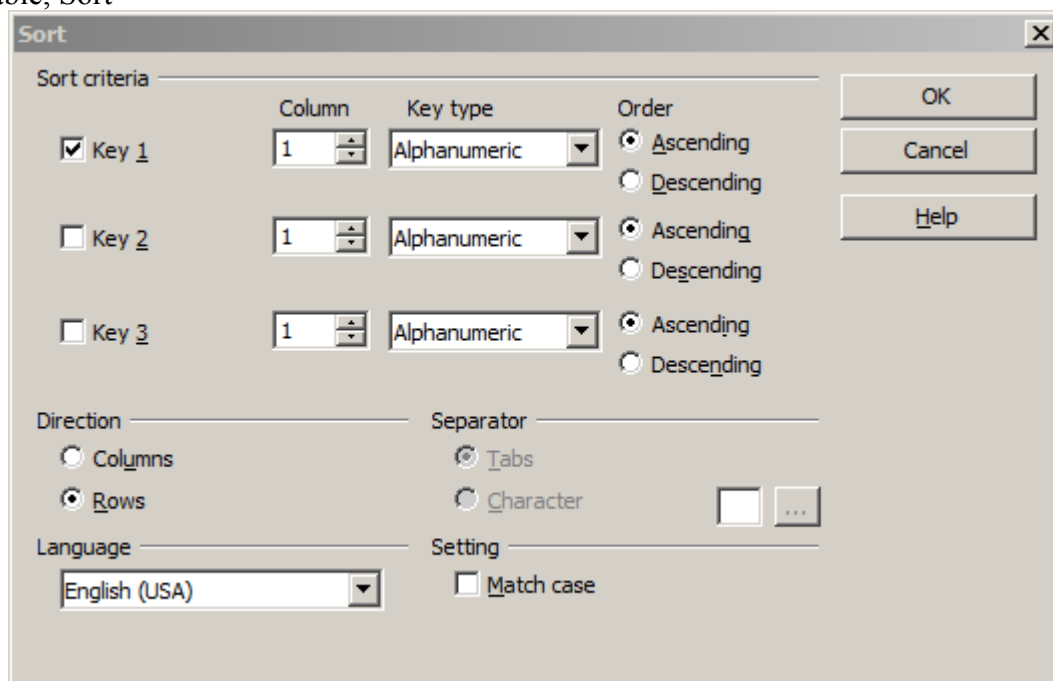


Starting table

| Row | Background color |
|-----|------------------|
| 2 | red |
| 3 | green |
| 1 | blue |

Recheck the problem in newer version of Writer 11 july 2012
Windows 7 Professional, x64, service pack 1, all current updates
LibreOffice 3.5.4.2

Copy the table above, select 3 rows (without header row)
Click Table, Sort



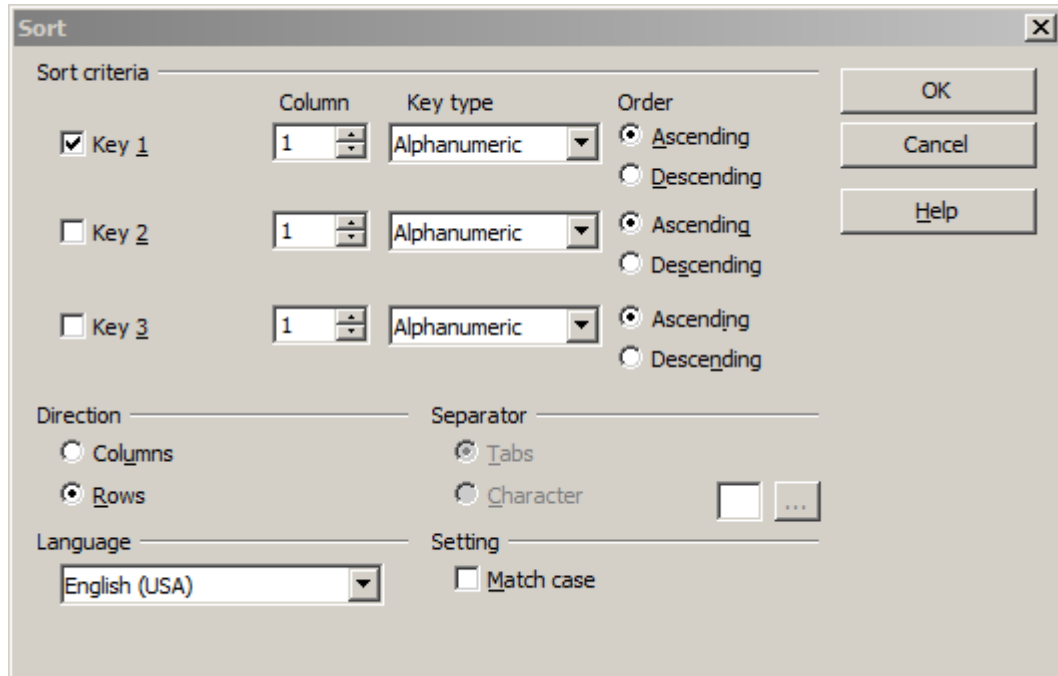
After sorting (ascending) on column 1, the same problem is still there

| Row | Background color |
|-----|------------------|
| 1 | blue |
| 2 | red |
| 3 | green |

i.e. the text is sorted correctly but the background colors remain in their original position. The expected behavior is that the red background associated with row 2 (or any other cell or row properties) should remain with the row after sorting. I also checked that the correct behavior is obtained when this table is sorted in Word 2010.
