Reading/Language Arts:

Word Work - We will review all CVC words with short vowels. Children need to have mastered these sounds and be able to apply them in reading and writing.

High Frequency/Popcorn/Heart words -the new words are: ride, ate, get, & well.

Reading theme: We have not had much time to read about and study Pilgrims and Native Americans. We will read stories, poems and nonfiction articles them. We will also read and write about Thanksgiving.

Math: Work on Topic 2: Concepts of Subtraction, will continue this week and next. We will write number sentences to solve a variety of math problems. Then we will write related facts ($7-4=3$, $7-3=4$ and $4+3=7$) and continue to explore the connection between addition and subtraction. While we problem solve, we will continue to work on basic fact fluency.

Thanksgiving Recital: We are very excited to invite you to attend the Annual First Grade Thanksgiving Recital. The first graders will dress as Native American and Pilgrim boys and girls. Each class will perform a song and poem for your enjoyment. The children are currently creating the invitations for you to join us on Wednesday, November 21, 2012 at 10:30 in the Multipurpose Room.
