„LibreOffice is a free and open source office suite, developed by The Document Foundation. It was released in 2010. The LibreOffice suite comprises programs to do word processing, spreadsheets, slideshows, diagrams, and compose math formulae. Between January 2011 (the first stable release) and October 2011, LibreOffice was downloaded about 15 million times.[16] During 2012, the office suite was downloaded about 15 million times.

LibreOffice is officially developed for Microsoft Windows (IA-32), Linux (IA-32 and x86-64) and OS X (IA-32 and x86-64). [24] and OpenBSD are maintained by contributors to those projects, respectively.[25][26][27] A community effort to port LibreOffice to the ARM architecture was announced in 2011. In 2011 plans were announced to port LibreOffice to both Android and iOS.[29] A-EON Technology announced plans to port LibreOffice to their AmigaOne X1000 computer running the latest AmigaOS.
