LibreOffice Option Print, note Paper Orientation is cut off, can be activated though.



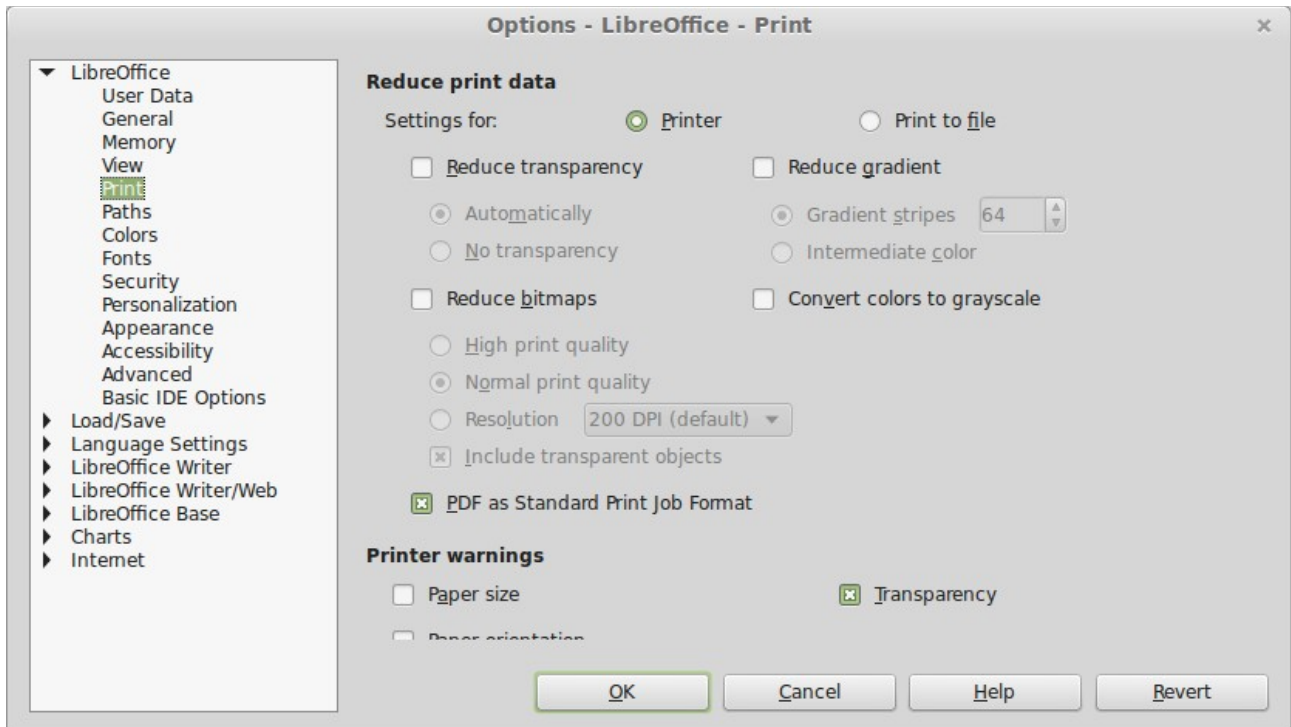
