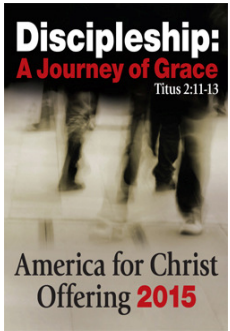

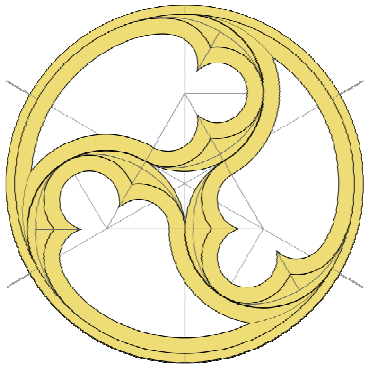

Word of the Month: Perichoresis

From Greek: περιχώρησις *perikhōrēsis*, rotation) describes the relationship between each person of the triune God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).

The relationship of the Triune God is intensified by the relationship of perichoresis. This *indwelling* expresses and realizes fellowship between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. It is intimacy.

Like water that spills from a full bucket when rotated, so is the love that overflows from the “divine dance” onto creation.




**Lenten Meditations**
