

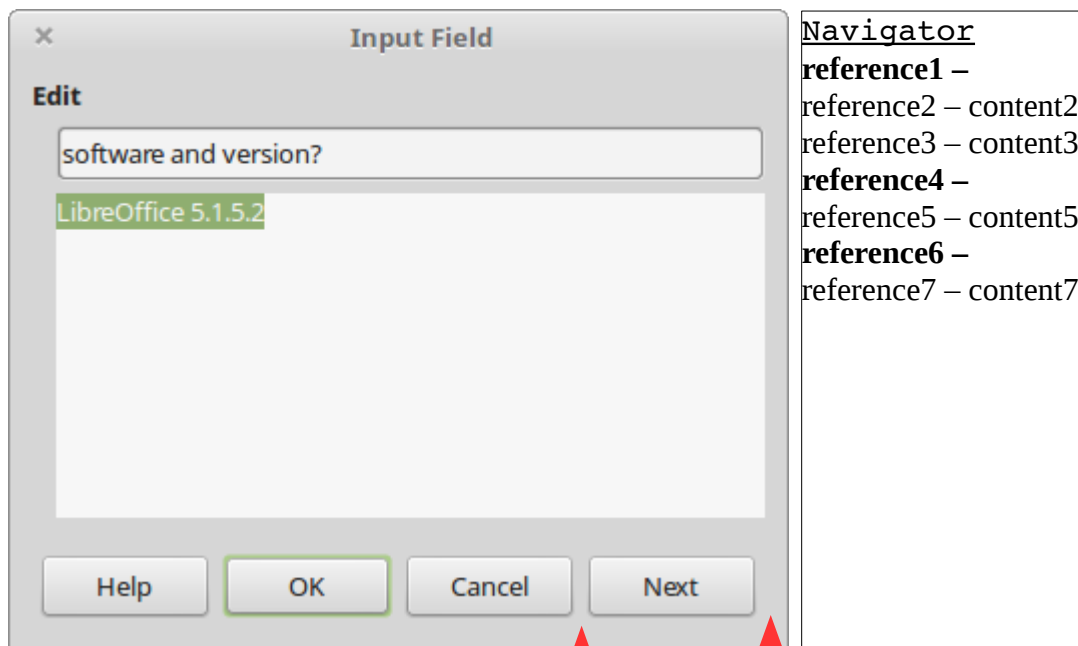

1st idea – improve dialog box

When pressing SHIFT+CTRL+F9 the following box appears (also when opening the file):



It would be nice to have also a 'Previous' button between 'Cancel' and 'Next'

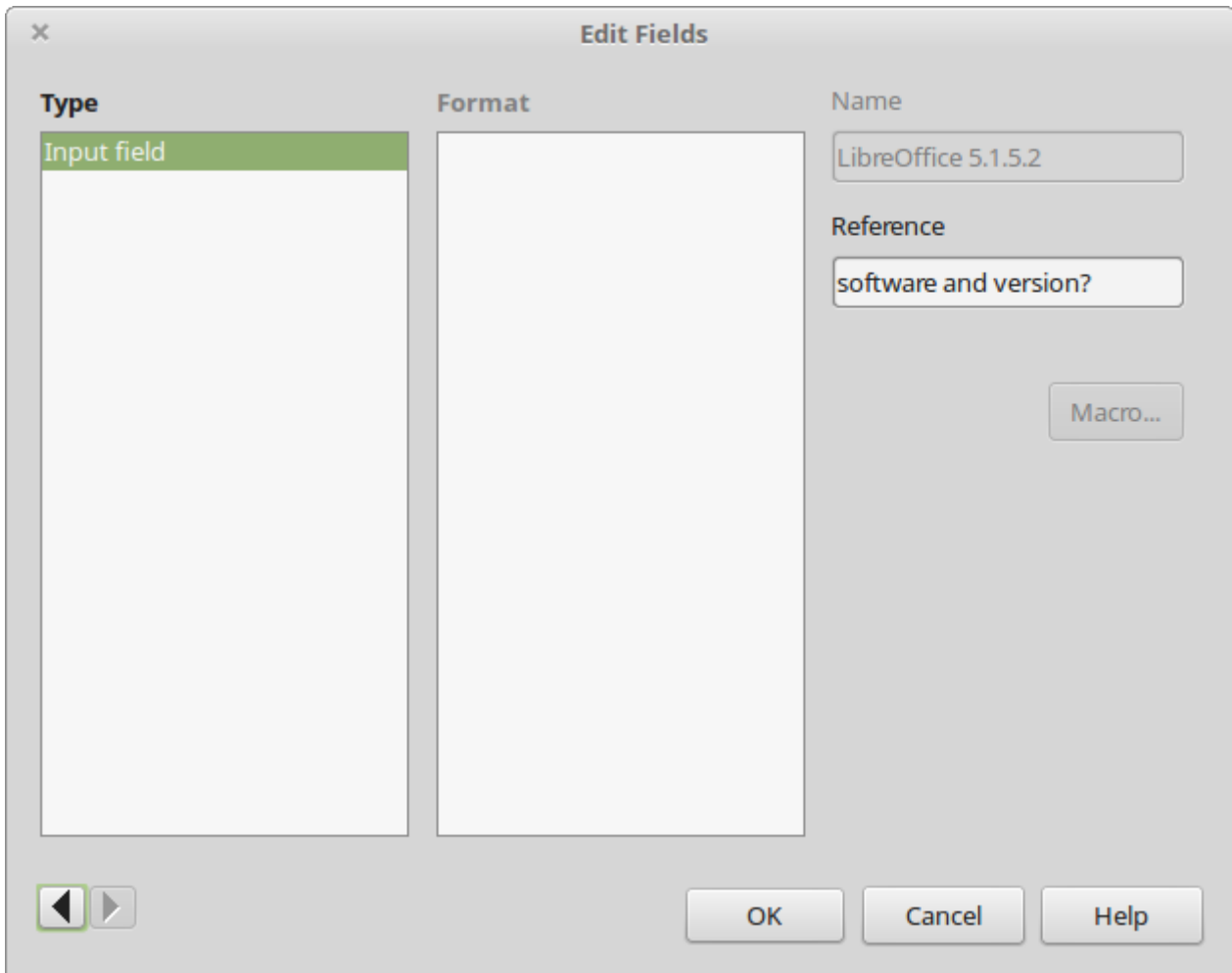
Previous

Navigator

The button 'Navigator' would open (extend the window) a small list of all input fields so there would be easy to see which fields are edited and which not and which have yet sample content – please see 2nd idea for more detail description how to achieve that. Then it would be easy to scroll and jump to particular field which is e.g. not yet edited or just want to change the content. Re-clicking the 'Navigator' button will hide the navigator. Also small arrow could be at top right corner to hide navigator as well but remain the dialog window open. It could be also remember last position whether to show navigator or not next time when this dialog window opened

2nd idea – improve editing box

When double-clicking on the field, the following dialog appears:



The 2nd idea is to redesign this window to offer more flexible approach.

The column 'Type' could be much smaller as there is written only 'Input field' which cannot be changed and that's OK but it does not need so large area for the value which cannot be changed. This field type could be just written as a fact on the gray area and it would be enough.

First column could be 'Input field navigator' or just 'Navigator' and there could be all input fields listed and also note which fields are viewed/edited since last time when file was opened – e.g. not bold and fields that have not viewed/edited – bold. Then it would be understandable also for people who have difficulties to see colors.

There could be fixed width of first column which describes field titles (references). Second column shows the content of appropriate field and there would be visually easy to see which fields have not yet any content.

There would be also appreciated if there could be possible to mark certain field 'unread' - just like e.g. in Thunderbird is possible to mark certain e-mail as unread using e.g. mouse right-click menu.

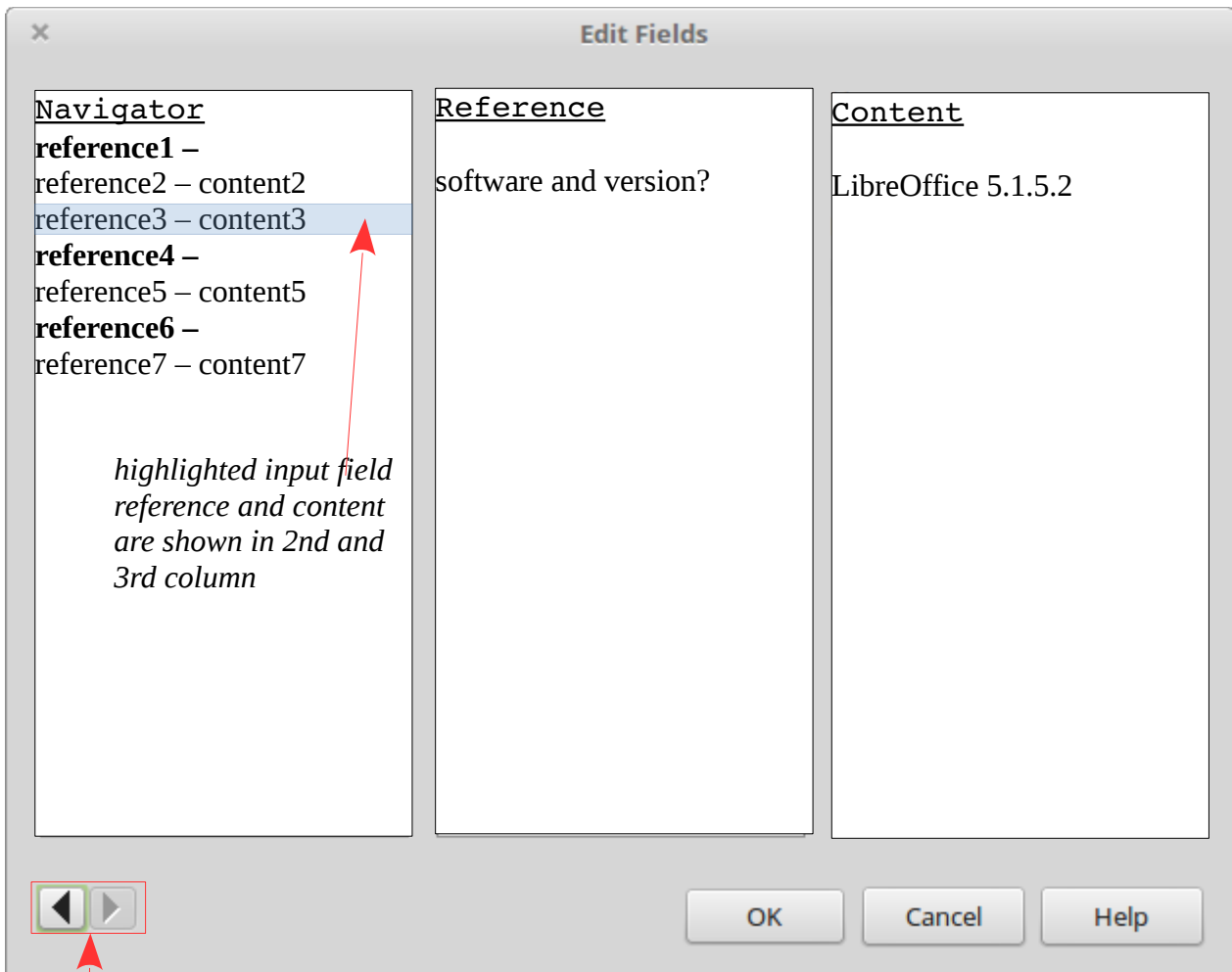
Then if there is a need to jump to certain field – by just clicking once with mouse left button, it would happen.

Second column could be 'Reference' and below of that column title would be the editable field like it currently is

Third column could be 'Content' and below of that column title would be the editable field where would be possible to edit the field content. Currently such field is viewable as 'Name' at top right corner and is not editable.

Then by clicking arrow buttons at bottom left corner there would be possible to move forwards and backwards between field and using the navigator to jump to particular input field.

Redesigned window:



These buttons can be still used to move backwards or forwards between input fields

3rd idea: improve shortcut keys

Currently to start fulfilling fields there is SHIFT+CTRL+F9 and it starts every time from the beginning. Idea would be that if I put the text cursor to certain field beginning then e.g. pressing SHIFT+ALT+F9 would start from that field where the text cursor was.

When to add the navigator as proposed in 1st idea then even in that way there would be easy to jump to particular input field to continue fulfilling where it was interrupted last time.
