

1. Make sure your system does not display Korean Characters (Hangeul). I removed all Korean fonts.

And you should see a Tofu (a question mark or a cross inside a box, or simply a box) below:

2. Input or paste two Chinese Characters. Here let's take 天地 (sky and earth) for example.

Don't forget to choose a font that supports Chinese Characters, such as 新細明體 (PMingLiU).

> 天地

3. Insert a Korean Character in the middle.

Since the Chinese font we use (新細明體/PMingLiU) does not support Korean Characters, you should see a Tofu in the middle.

> 天□地 <--- correct

4. Apply a font which doesn't support Chinese Characters, such as Calibri, Liberation Sans ... etc.

And the bug appears:

> 天地□ <--- wrong
