Project Overview

For users that want to get news recommendations on a daily basis, fetching content by drilling down from the current interest map view is not efficient. The "List View" is will enable frequent users of the Interest Dashboard to quickly access their news feed.

- 3 Providing top news stories by default, with the ability to drill down





Summary of Concept A: "Toggle"

Add a simple control that allows a user to switch between Map and List Views. By default, the user's top 10 interest are displayed in simple list format, but they can drill down into any interest to select or unselect related categories. This would also preserve the current experience.






Concept B: Interest Feeds, List Item Rollover




Concept B: Interest Feeds, Interest Categories Exposed








