# OBJECTIVES



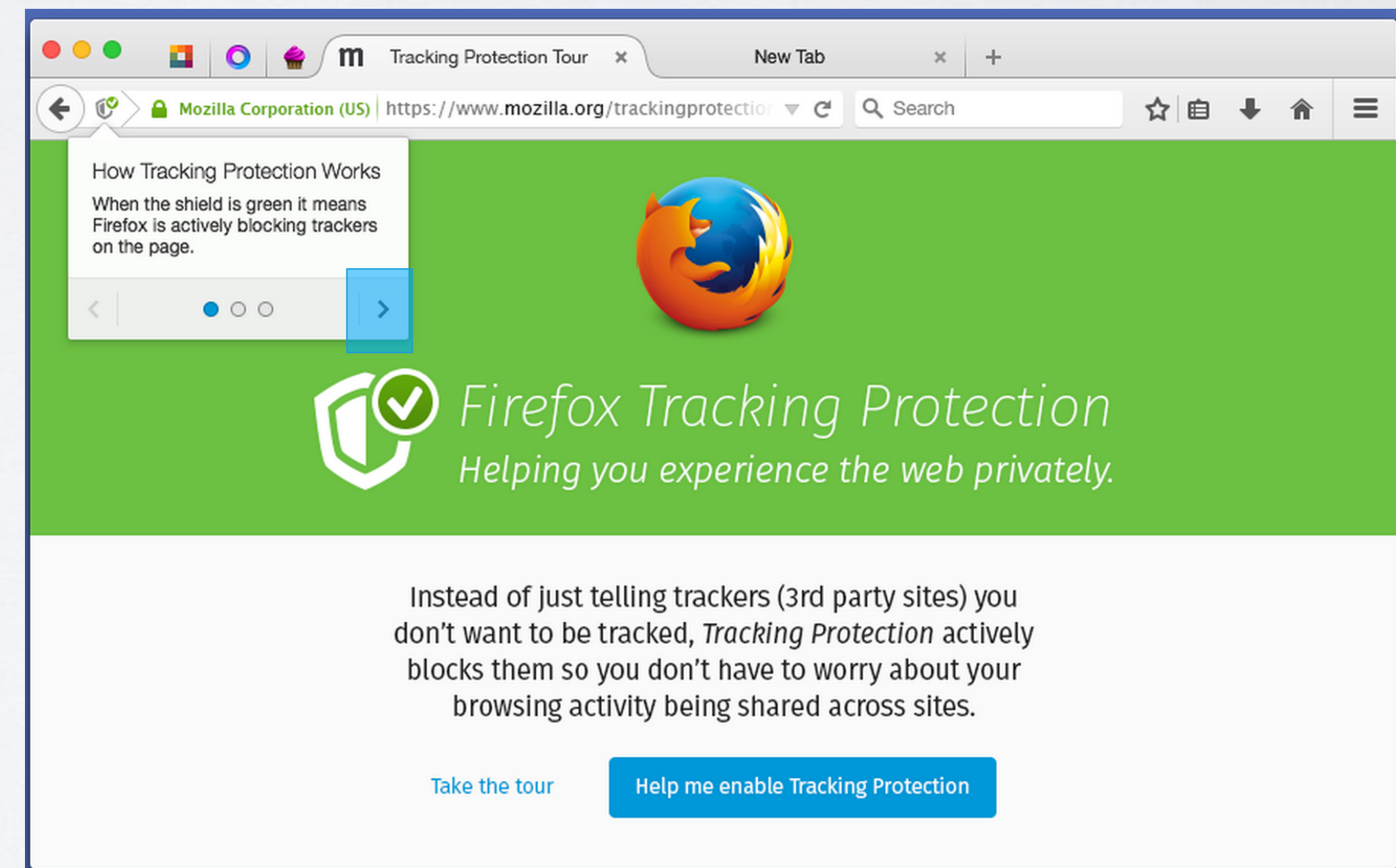
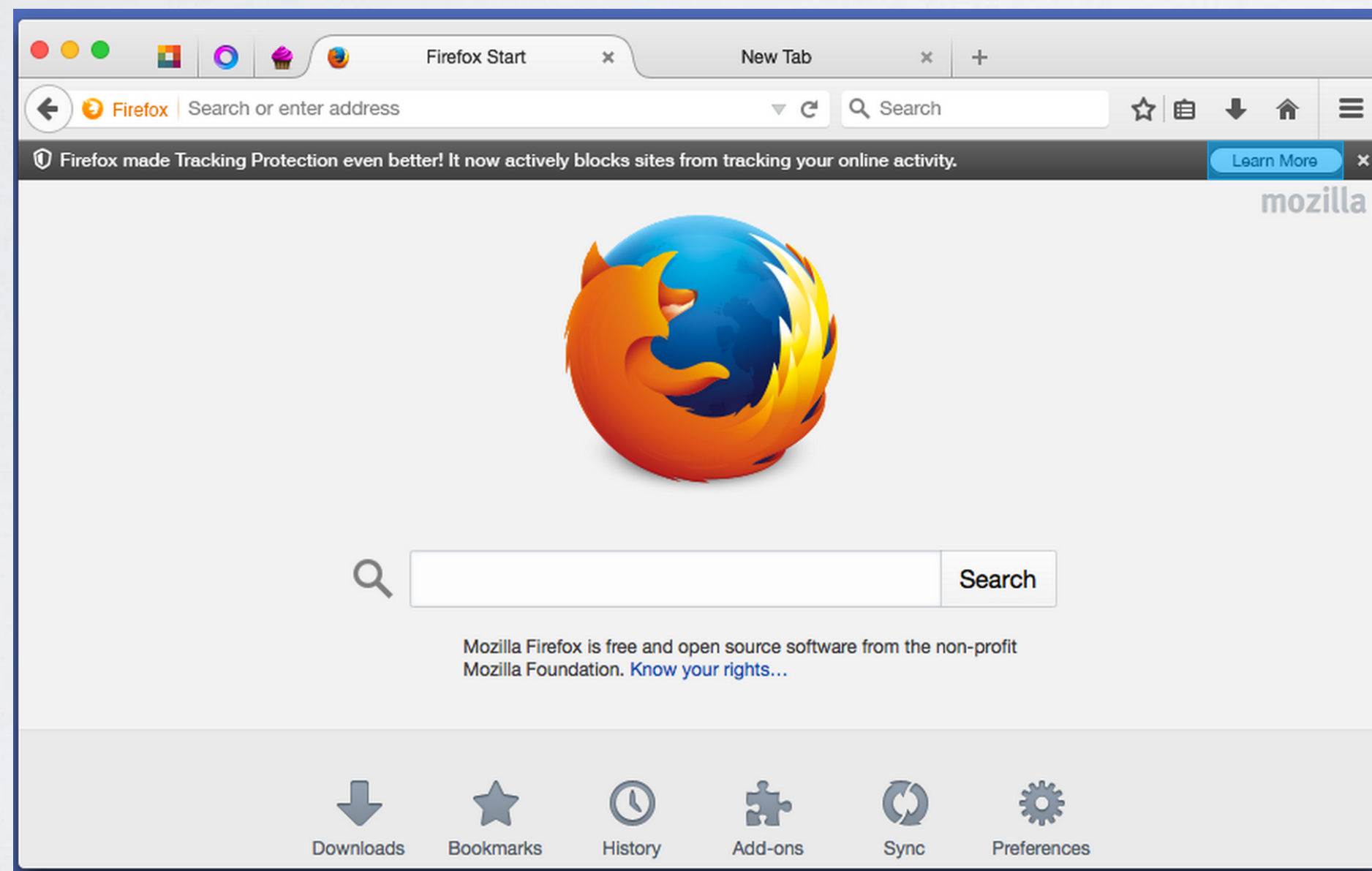
- Provide richer tracking protection than just broadcasting Do Not Track to websites by actively blocking tracking elements
- Help users unfamiliar with tracking understand the value of tracking protection in protecting their privacy on the web



# TOUCH POINTS

## Onboarding

Opt-in existing Do Not Track users to Tracking Protection. Present an optional tour (Learn more) where users can learn how this feature works.

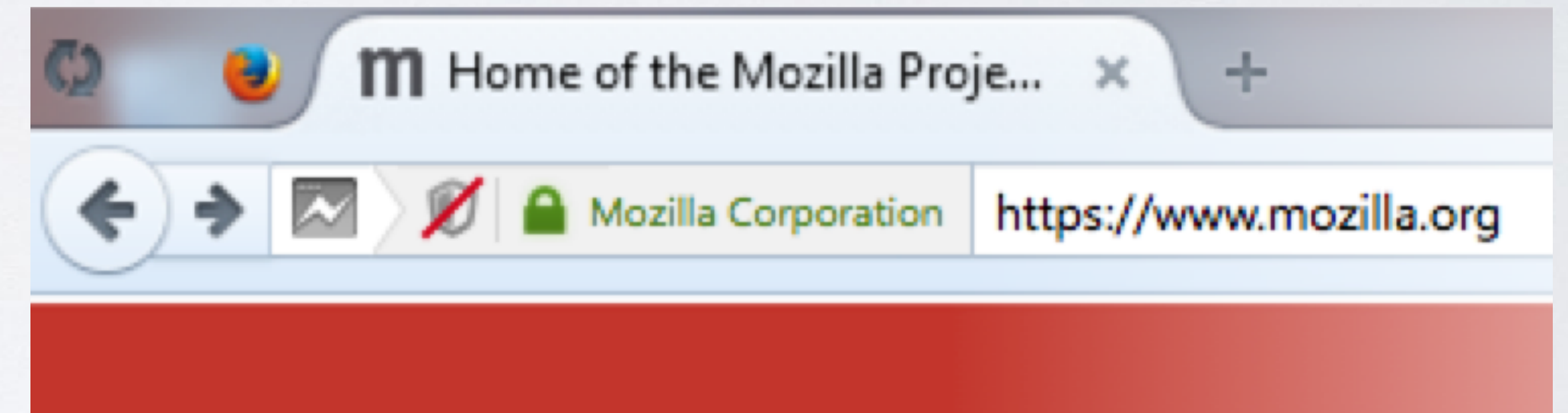
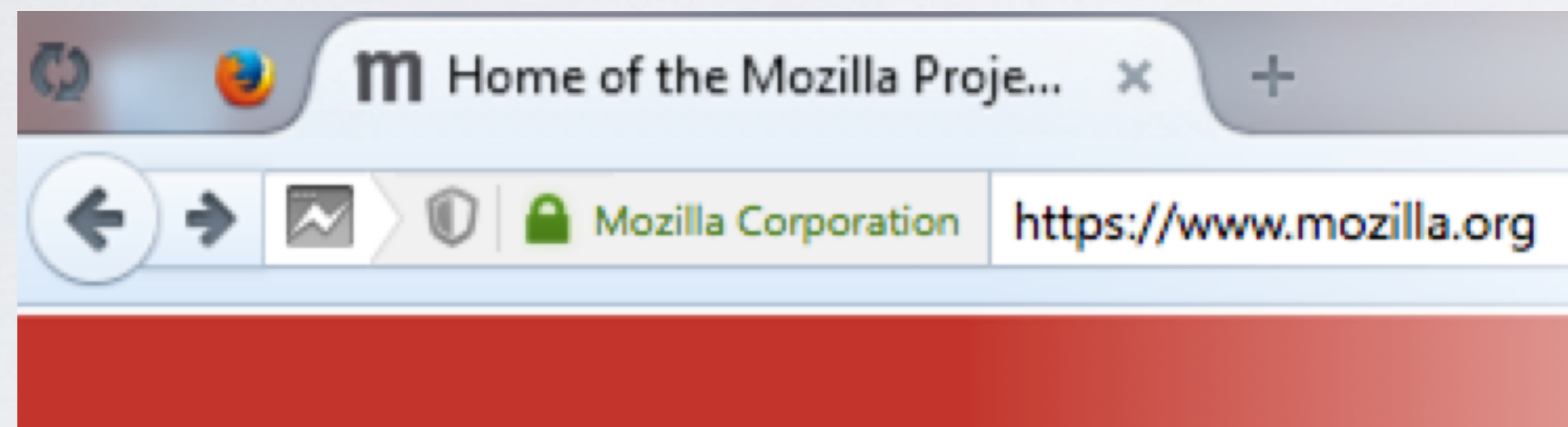




# TOUCH POINTS

## Identity Block

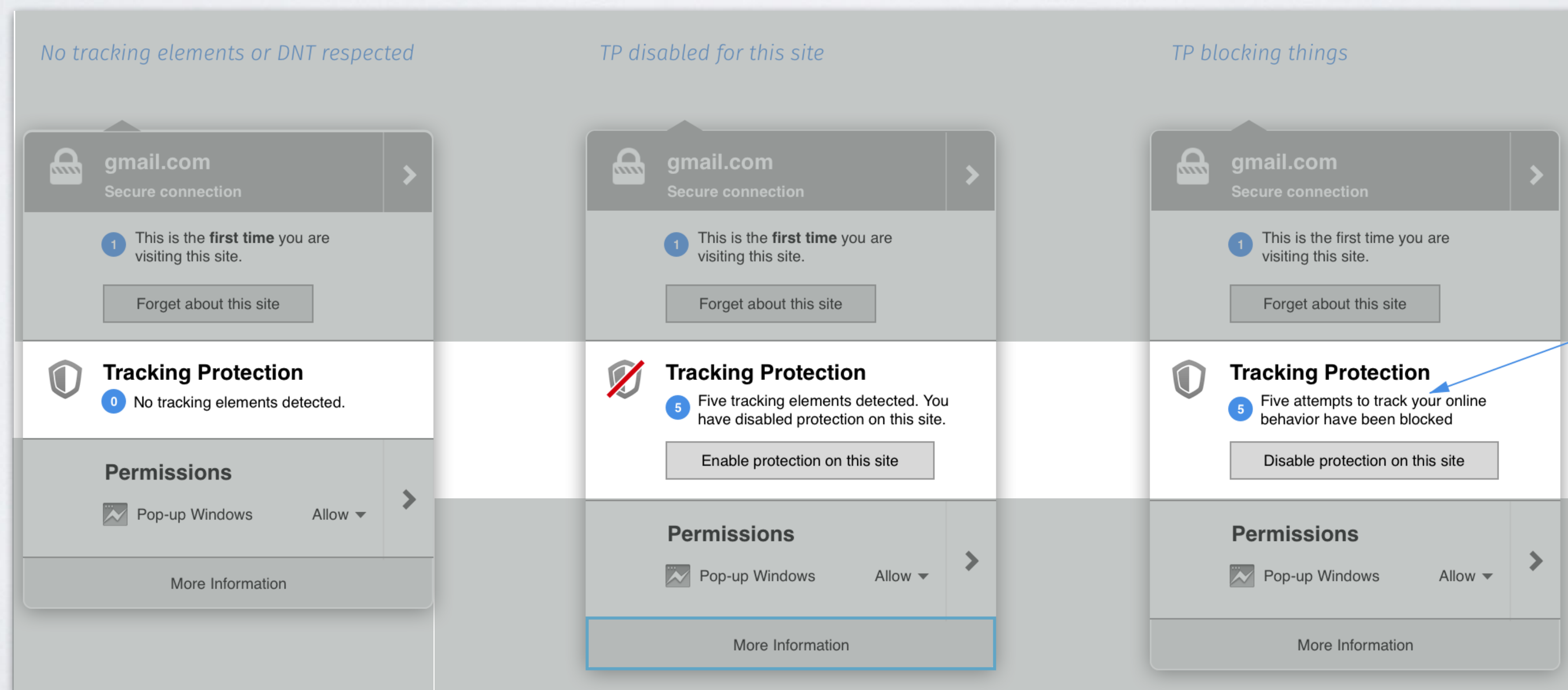
Icon (shield) for Tracking Protection provides feedback when the user is on a site and Tracking Protection is enabled and blocking trackers. Users can also see when they have disabled Tracking Protection for a specific site.



# TOUCH POINTS

## Door Hanger

In addition to showing security status for the current site, the door hanger provides a read out of the number of trackers found and whether they're being blocked or not (based on if TP is enabled/disabled). For sites that respect Do Not Track, the door hanger reflects that no tracking elements have been detected.

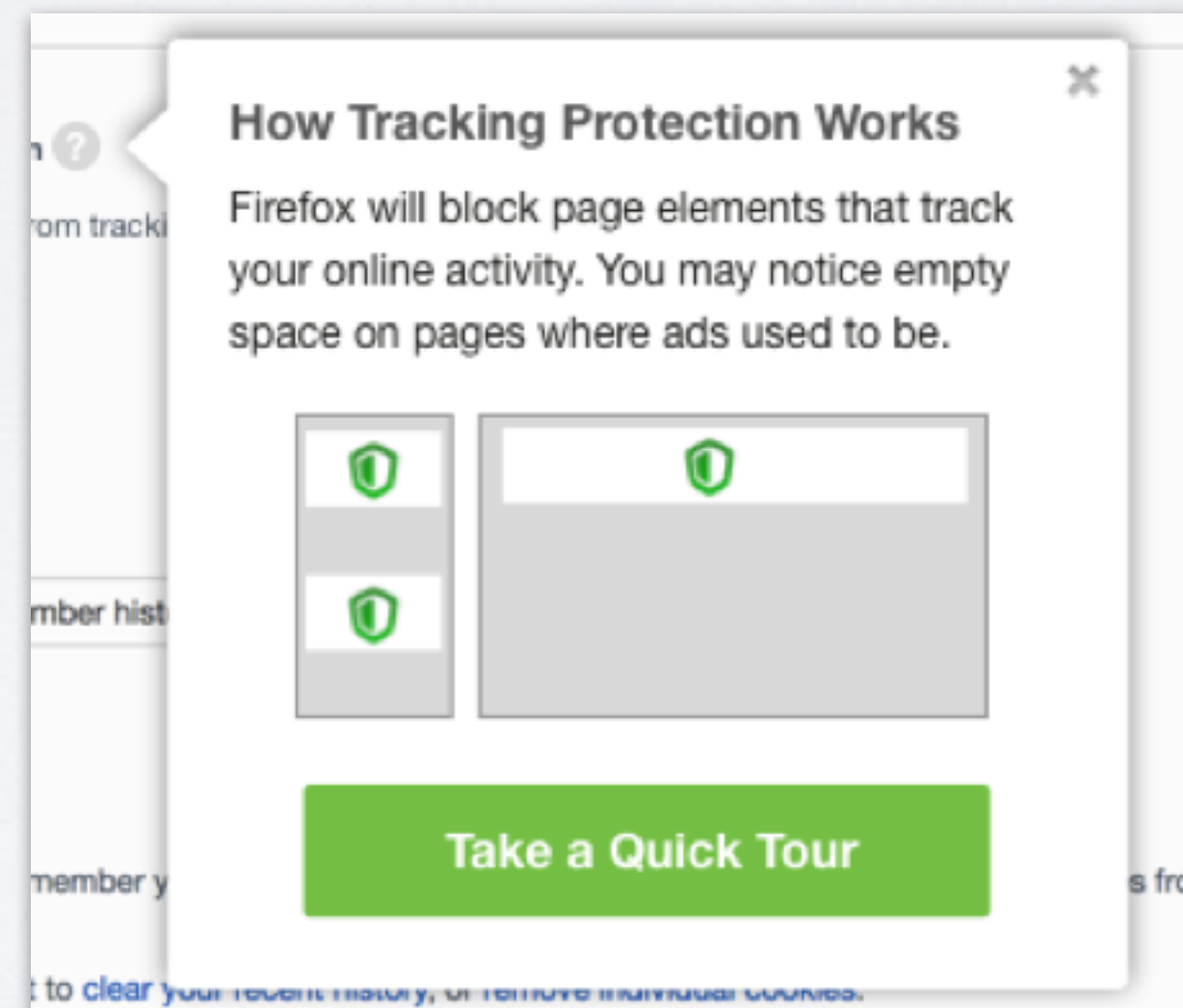
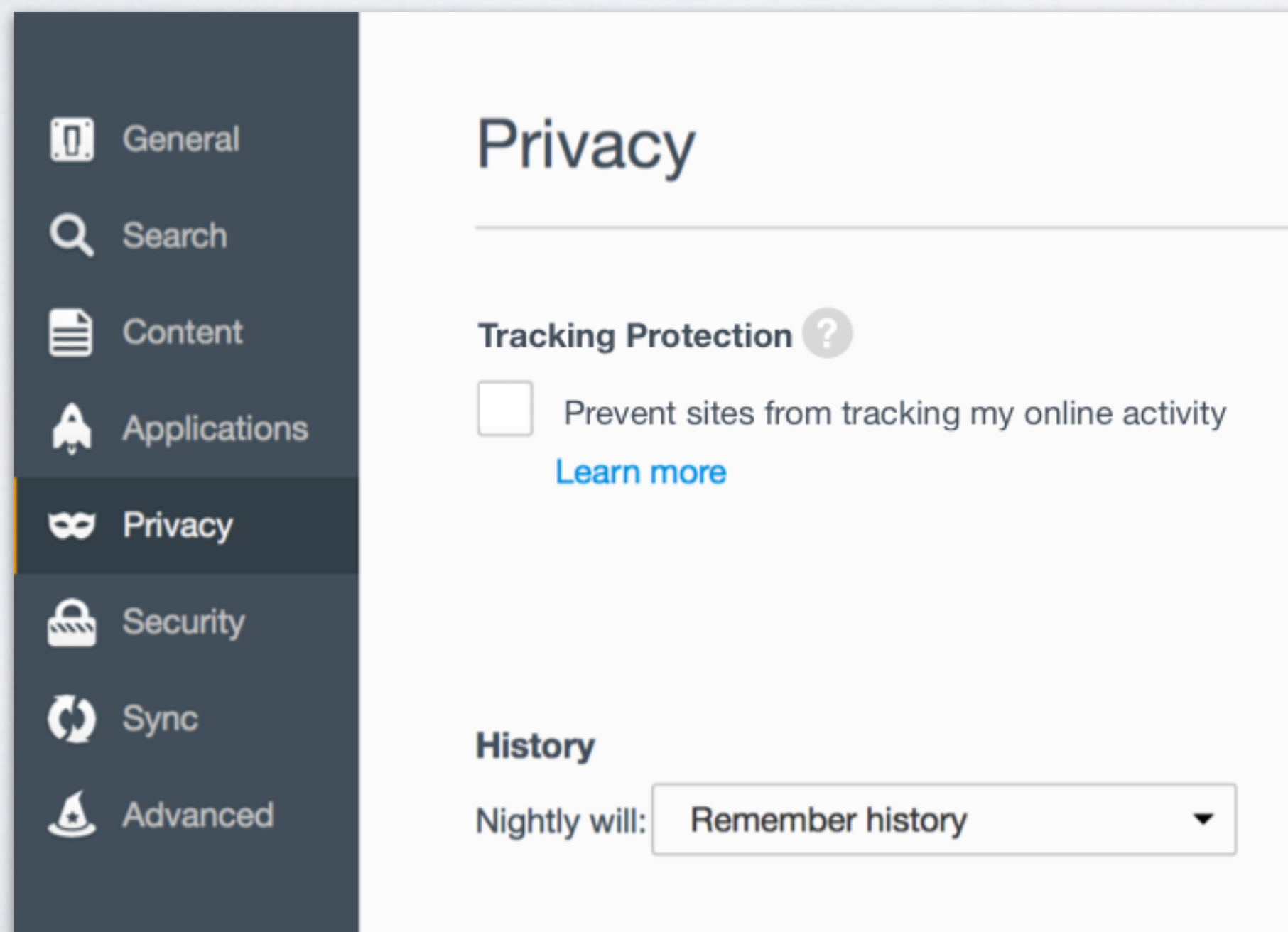




# TOUCH POINTS

## Preferences

On release, all users will see their preference changed to reflect a new name - Tracking Protection. This preference will be enabled for existing Do Not Track users. Other users that discover this new setting and want to learn more can access a tooltip that can launch the on boarding tour and show them how to enabled tracking protection.
