




Step 1 : open Firefox with bug1428725.html and open Web Console




Step 2 : open a new tab on about:debugging and go to Workers



### Step 1 : open Nightly with bug1428725.html and open Web Console




Step 2 : open a new tab on about:debugging and go to Workers
