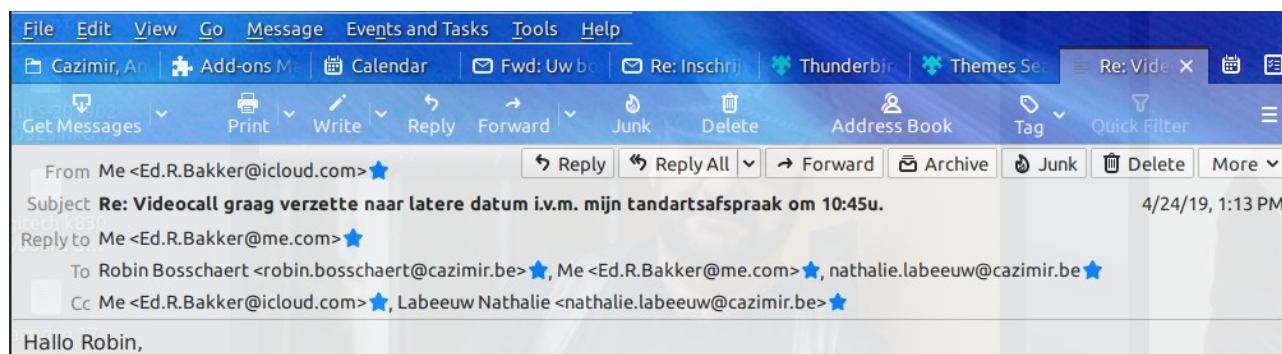


Mozilla Thunderbird 60-6-1 email addressing bug!

As explained; Thunderbird adds-up email addresses with each mail: here you see 'same email addresses are both in 'To' and 'CC' address fields while originally this is not the case!

My version of Thunderbird:



Running on Kubuntu 19.04 today May 17th 2019.

Explanation in detail:

Thunderbird has a serious 'cock-up' between 2 functions:

- 1) Typing a few characters of a 'known' (learned) email address should 'fill up' the rest of the email address.
- 2) Hitting 'Reply To' should give a new blank email with 'To' and 'CC' filled with concerned email addresses, taken from the mail it was clicked 'Reply To'.

Thunderbird AND saves the email address in the original 'To' field and 'hiddenly' it stoves away the rest of the email addresses.

When clicked 'Reply To' it shows the 'To' address, 1 address in 'CC' and the 'hidden stoways' are added at time of clicking 'Send'.

These are 2 separate functions which should stay separate and not be mixed up...

Meaning; if I use 1 'To' address and 2 'CC' addresses in mail one; I click Send. Then I get a reply from the 'To' and want to reply to him/her alone, but not to the 2nd 'CC' address, there's NO option to remove the 2nd 'CC' address as it's hidden, and he / she WILL get my reply too!

I had serious problems with this in a judicial case against an opponent being 2nd in the 'CC' mail address field....

Hope it's clear as the bug is there for ages already!!
