

# Error opening PHP files #14952

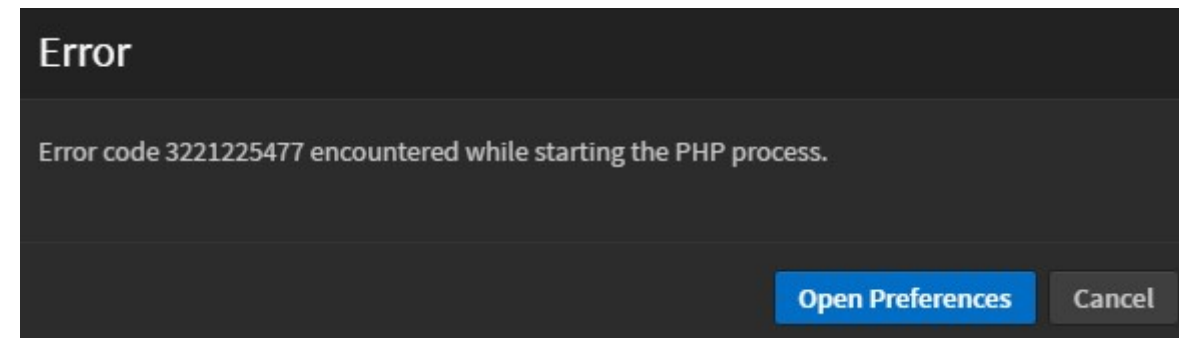

Everytime I open a PHP file in Brackets, the error as shown below is displayed.



I do have `executablePath` set to the correct `php.exe` path but it didn't solve the issue.

The error, however, doesn't cause any issues while editing, saving or executing the PHP code. It's shown only when a PHP file is opened.

How can I get rid of this?

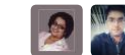

I had it as double slash (`\\`) from before.

Huh, that does seem right. Assuming that you modified brackets.json correctly, you can try one more thing. Extract [php 7](#) directly in some other folder, like on desktop and then provide that path. Make sure the folder has necessary permissions. If this works then I guess the problem is with the php executable that wamp provides.
