

What is Camino?

Camino™ (formerly known as Chimera) is a web browser for [Mac OS X](#) that has a [Cocoa](#) user interface, and embeds the [Gecko](#) layout engine. It is intended to be a simple, small and fast browser for Mac OS X.

Camino is still in the beta stage of its development. It is stable enough to use day-to-day, but you may still encounter bugs. You should always keep backup copies of important data that you use with Camino (e.g. your bookmarks file).
