Tamarin

Tamarin is a JavaScript engine written in C++. It currently implements Adobe ActionScript® 3 (a superset of ECMAScript Edition 3) and is embedded within the Adobe® Flash® Player 9.



XPCOM

XPCOM is a cross platform component object model. It has multiple language bindings, letting the XPCOM components be used and implemented in JavaScript, Java, and Python in addition to C++.
