
DETAILS

1.1 Editor Report 1: Editor Performance Reports


- Available to a specific editor only
- Integrated into the AMO Editors tools menu
- Details which add-ons they've reviewed during the specified timeframe
 - o Allow them to enter a date range and see performance results for that timeframe
 - Display add-on name, review status, date & time, category, type (Firefox, Thunderbird, etc.)
 - Allow sorting by:
 - Add-on name
 - Date/time of review
 - Type of add-on reviewed (Firefox, Thunderbird, etc.)
 - Category of add-on
- Roll-up weekly totals at the bottom and compare to an average of the whole editorial team during that week
- Roll-up of MTD reviews and compare to an average of the whole editorial team during that month
- Roll-up of YTD reviews and compare to an average of the whole editorial team during that year
- The report should be available to AMO managers for review and allow for the selection of anyone on the editorial team. This could be done via a dropdown that lists all of the editors and is only available to a select number of people.

1.2 Editor Report 2: Graphs


- Graphs showing when they've been most active over a period of time
- Would like to see the following graphs:
 - o Graph 1:
 - Activity by months based the number of add-ons reviewed (line chart)
 - Activity average of the rest of the editors based on the same time period to allow the editor to compare against the team (line chart)



 Category reviewed breakdown. For example, in Feb 09, 50% of the reviews were Appearance, 20% were Security, 5% were Toolbars, 25% were Music. Allow graph to be filtered down by month/year or year. (pie chart -2D)



 Category reviewed breakdown based on average for the whole team. Same as above but based on team stats as a whole to allow editor to compare against team results. (pie chart -2D)
