1. Pledge Panel



When Developer initiates pledge drive, the current Contributions Panel is replaced by a new Pledge Panel.

Clicking on Contribute button now opens the

Contribution Lightbox (Page 2).



2. Contribution Lightbox



The Contributions Lightbox replaces the former Contribution drop-down, and lets the user have more choice about how, when, and why they make their contributions.

Clicking outside of the lighbox dismisses it.

- Title has same formatting as H2 element.
- Include a brief reiteration of what is happening, restate the name of the add-on, and highlight that PayPal will be used.

- Choices for how much to contribute: a. The suggested amount (default).
 - b. A user-specified amount.
 - c. A user-specified subscription.

If any text is entered into a text box, its radio button is automatically selected.

Provide a space for contributors to leave comments or make requests (feature tipping).
