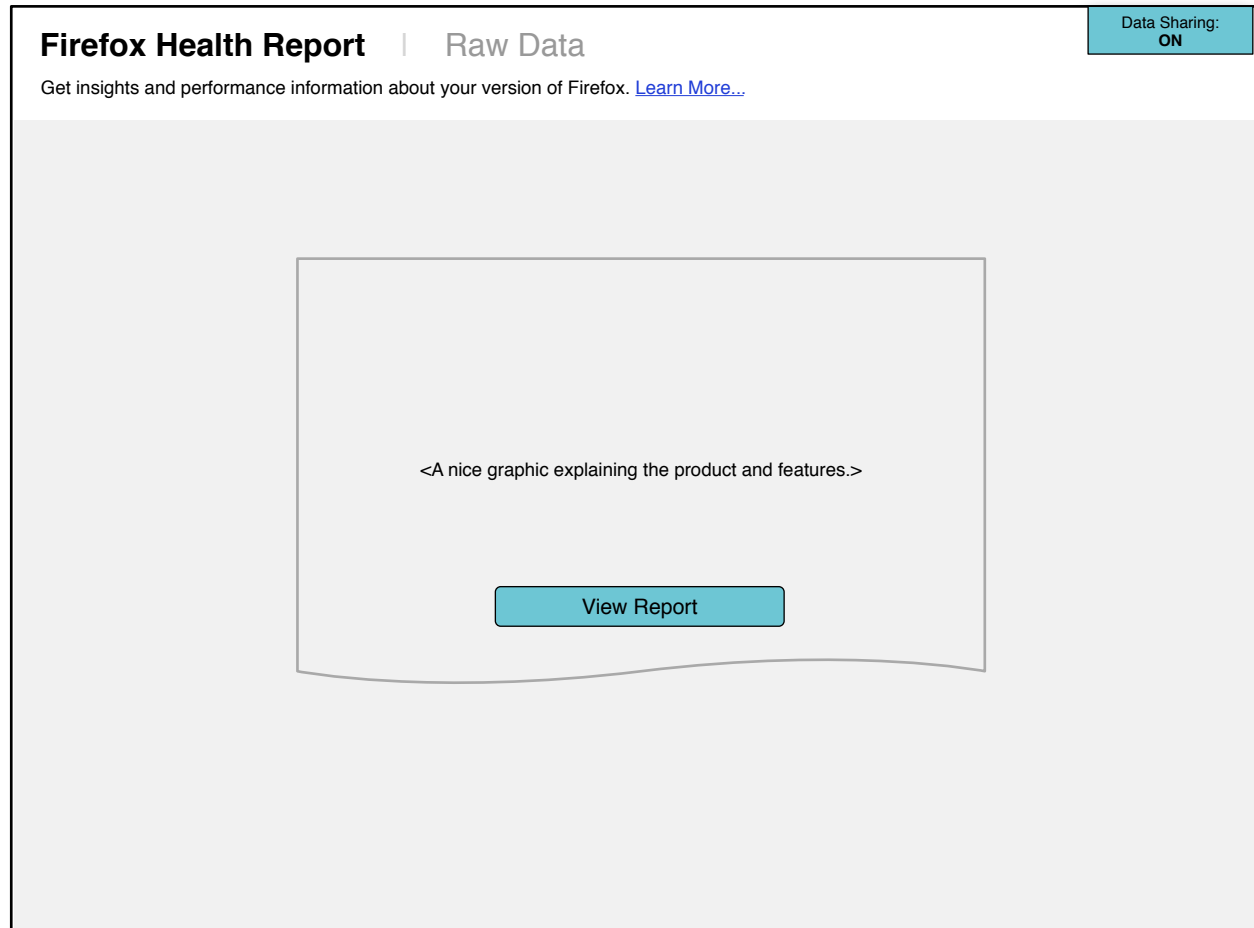

Cover Page



Cover Page

The cover page is a custom page the user sees before being viewing the dashboard. Ideally, we use this page pattern only when we have a unique message to convey. On all other times, navigating to About:FHR just displays the dashboard immediately.

Some instances when a cover page would be helpful:

- First time the user visits the FHR page
- Any time we include a major new feature in FHR
- [Maybe] To mark big milestones such as an anniversary greeting for when the user first installed Firefox



Background

Since this is a cover page, the background should be visually distinct from the dashboard pages.

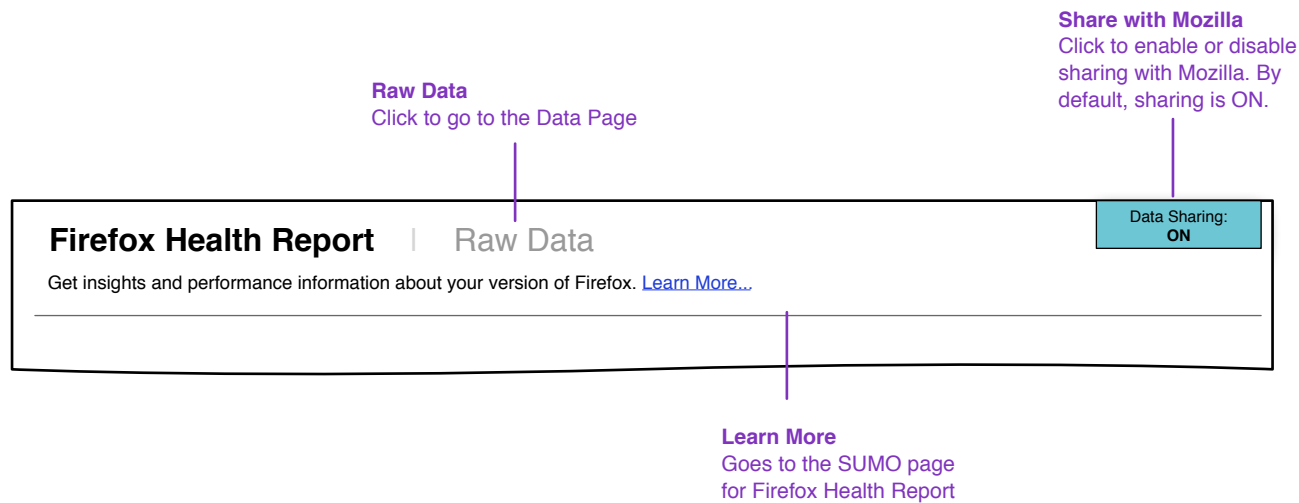

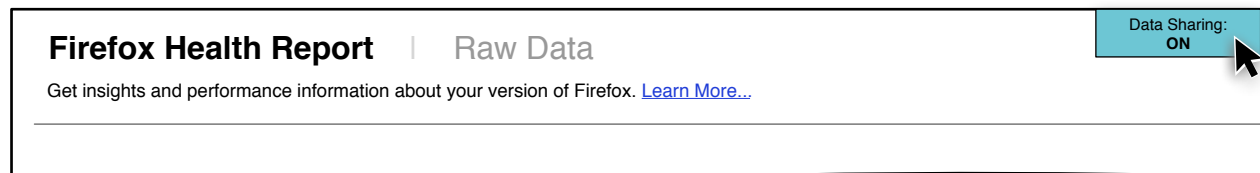

Header

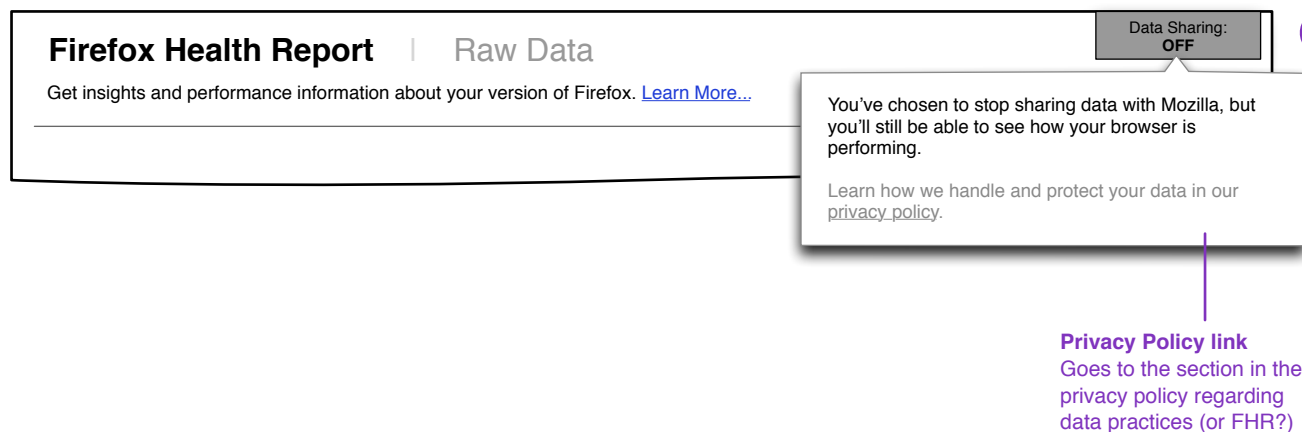
The header shows up in all the pages of the Firefox Health Report. It is a way for the user to navigate between the dashboard and the data page, as well as quickly view whether data is being shared with Mozilla or not.



Disabling Sharing



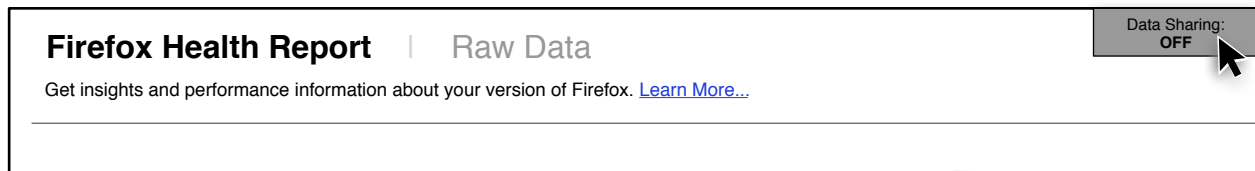
- 1 **State: Sharing Enabled**
The user clicks on the Share Indicator



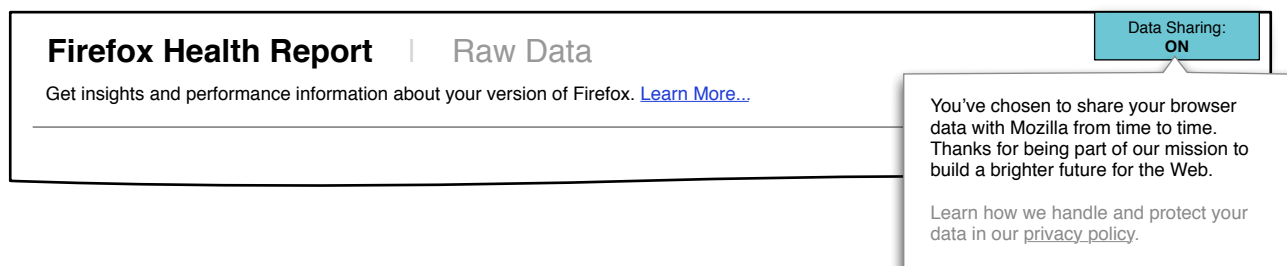
- 2 **State: Sharing Disabled**
The Share Indicator is greyed out, and the status message says sharing is disabled. A message is displayed onscreen explaining the changes to the user.

The message should explain that he isn't sharing data with Mozilla from this point forward, but that his full Health Report is still available to him.

Enabling Sharing



- 1 **State: Sharing Disabled**
The user clicks on the Share Indicator



- 2 **State: Sharing Enabled**
The Share Indicator lights up, and the status message says sharing is enabled. A message is displayed onscreen explaining the changes to the user.

The message should explain that by enabling sharing, data will be sent to Mozilla periodically. It should also reinforce the idea that sharing data makes the user part of our mission.

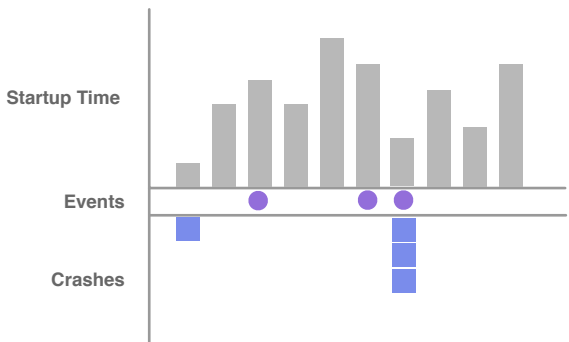

Vital Stats

Vital Stats contains quantified information about the user's browsing habits. It is meant to provide an overview, not as a place to find detailed information or data.

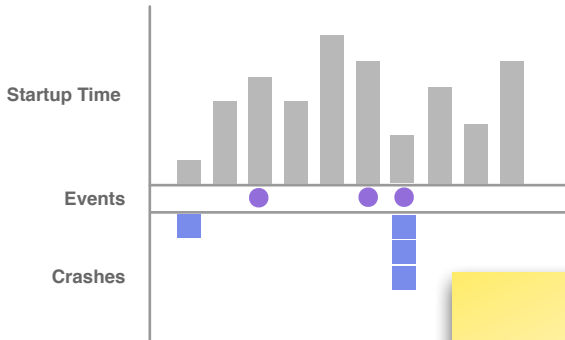

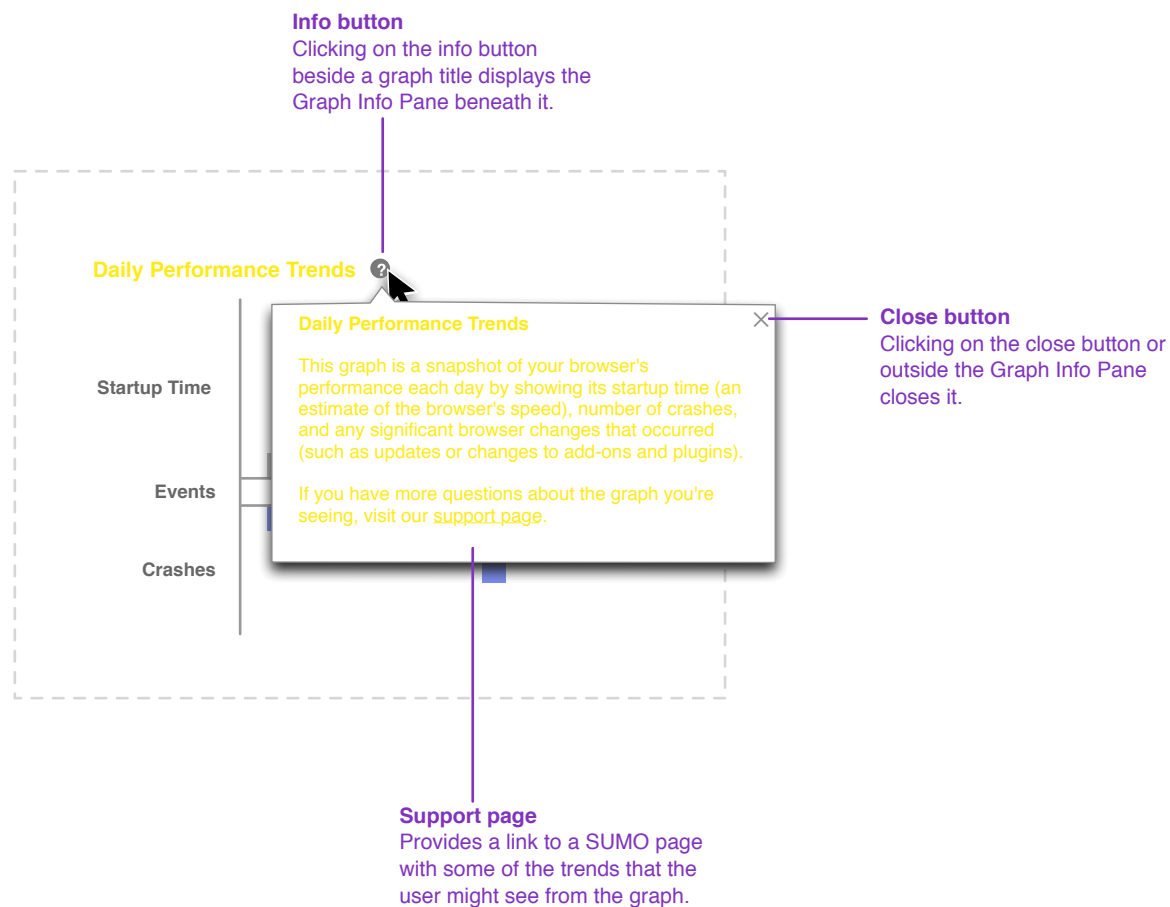

The graphs contain detailed information about the browser's performance and other metrics that are important to the user.

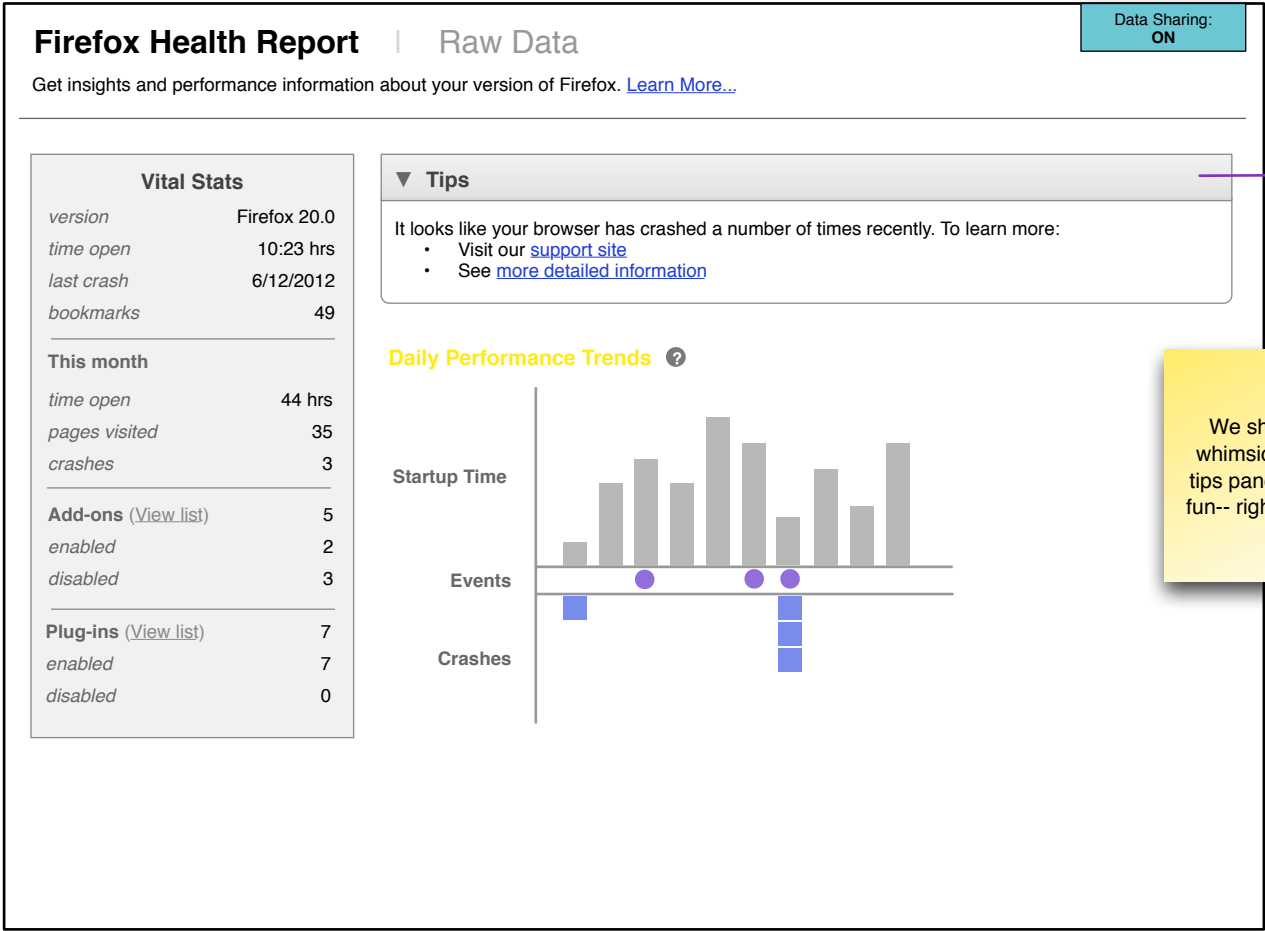
Graph Information Pane

The Graph Info Pane explains the data the graph represents.



Tips Pane

The Tips Pane is displayed above the graphs when we have information or suggestions that we want to call the user's attention to. Once the information is no longer pertinent (e.g. the user has already updated his browser), the Tips Pane disappears.

4 Frequent FHR User who Disabled Sharing

We could show a message for users who seem to be using FHR a lot but have disabled sharing with Mozilla. The message wording should explain that by doing so, the user is contributing to our mission and helping to improve our products.

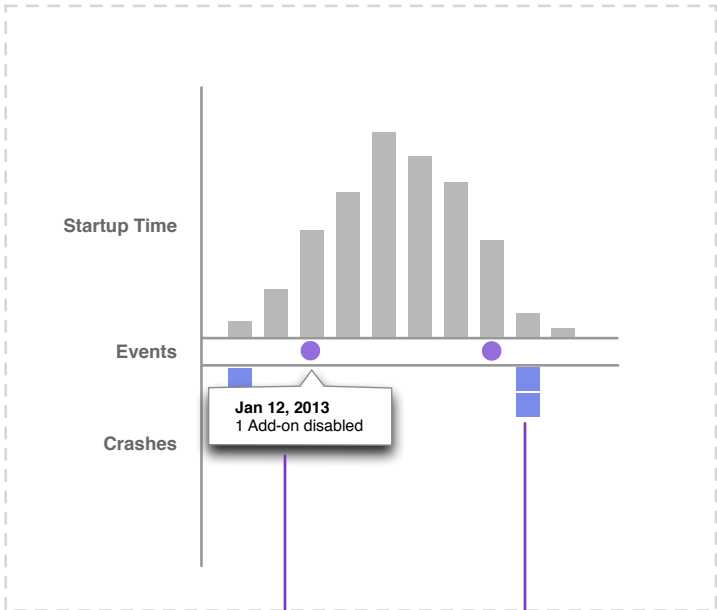
Personas (Best Guess)



	Quantifier	Optimizer	Troubleshooter	Auditor	Onlooker (Non-FHR user)
Who he/ she is	Likes to see the big picture of his browser use and visualizing trends. Enjoys the data for its own sake, not necessarily because he wants to do something with it.	Wants to make sure her browser is as efficient as possible. Will explore settings and research ways to maximize performance.	Is looking for information that can help him diagnose a problem. Will probably only visit the page when there seems to be a recurring issue.	Privacy-sensitive user who wants to see what data Mozilla is collecting about her. Cares about our mission and likes to customize her privacy and security choices.	Won't visit the FHR page because he's afraid that he might break something. Alternative Graph Designs

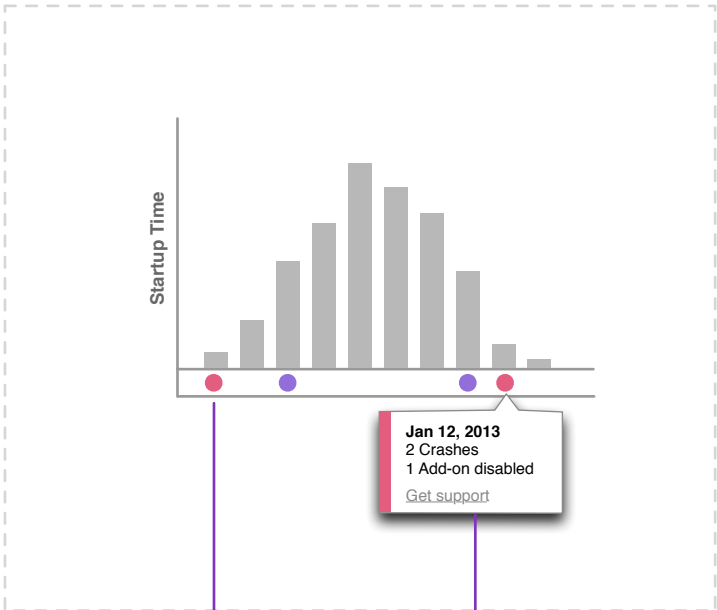
Idea 1: Startup Time + Events + Crashes



Clicking or hovering on an event displays a description of the event/s. The description overlaps the crash graph in this design.

Shows the number of crashes per day. This graph could be very bare depending on frequency of crashes.

Idea 2: Startup Time + Events



Crashes are indicated in a different color from other events.

Clicking or hovering on an event displays a description of the event/s.
