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





Cover Page


The cover page is a custom page the user sees before being viewing the dashboard. Ideally, we use this page pattern only when we have a unique message to convey. On all other times, navigating to About:FHR just displays the dashboard immediately.



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Header

The header shows up in all the pages of the Firefox Health Report. It is a way for the user to navigate between the dashboard and the data page, as well as quickly view whether data is being shared with Mozilla or not.



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Disabling Sharing



State: Sharing Enabled

State: Sharing Disabled

The Share Indicator is greyed out, and the status message says sharing is disabled. A message is displayed onscreen explaining the changes to the user.

The message should explain that he isn't sharing data with Mozilla from this point forward, but that his full Health Report is still available to him.

The user clicks on the Share Indicator



State: Sharing Enabled
The Share Indicator lights up, and the status message says sharing is enabled. A message is displayed onscreen explaining the changes to

the user.

The message should explain that by enabling sharing, data will be sent to Mozilla periodically. It should also reinforce the idea that sharing data makes the user part of our mission.

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Dashboard


The dashboard is the main page the user will interact with to view the browser's health report.



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Daily Startup Time Graph

This graph shows the user the median and all the startup times for their copy of the browser per day



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Startup Time Graph Alternate Views

The user can view all the data points for the day by showing the "All" graph.

Case 1: The user toggles to the "All" View Startup Time by Day Graph: Average Time to start (in seconds) **Today's Data Points** No median is provided for today's data points because the day isn't complete yet. **Actual Data Points** Data points that do not represent the median are displayed less prominently (here, they are Startup time helps determine how well your version of Firefox is performing. 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Tips Pane

The Tips Pane is displayed above the graphs when we have information or suggestions that we want to call the user's attention to. Once the information is no longer pertinent (e.g. the user has already updated his browser), the Tips Pane disappears.

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Data Page


The Data Page is the "back panel" of the Firefox Health Report. It's displayed when the user clicks the "Raw Data" link from the Dashboard page. The Data page is separated from the Dashboard because it's for even more advanced users who would like to see the raw data and reports sent to Mozilla.







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Graph Zoom (Future)

The user can zoom into the graph if there are more than 14 days of data collected.

Case 2: The user zooms into the graph





Zooming into a graph

When the user hovers over the graph, the mouse pointer turns into a zoom-in magnifying glass. Clicking on the graph zooms into that portion of the graph, showing the surrounding 14 days of data.

The zoom-in function is only available if there are more than 14 days of data available.

Zooming out of a graph

If the graph is zoomed in to 14 days of data, hovering over it displays a zoom-out magnifying glass. Clicking on the magnifying glass displays a view with data for 90 days.

The zoom-out function is only available if there are more than 14 days of data available.





