# A taxonomy update solves the following:

- 1 Aligns taxonomy with Firefox Funnel project goals by grouping and promoting the Firefox family of products.
- 2 Solves parent/child redundancy issue with the label "Products". (See following page for example)
- Updates product terminology (ie: B2G > Firefox OS)
- 4 Dispays labels and links in a way that creates better expectation for the user. See: Tools and Innovation sections. (ie: Pancake is a Labs product, Bugzilla and Firebug are Developer Tools. For this reason I would not display them here at the same level as their parent links.)

- Recategorize Thunderbird since it is no longer being updated. In this example I have placed it in the Community Supported group.
- By adding a "Mozilla" section which holds products that aren't part of the Fx family, we would need to make sure that the redundancy in names isn't confusing to the user. (ie: Marketplace, Persona)
- Remove "Reserved for Future Products" slots. It is ok if an odd number of items are shown.

This direction promotes the Firefox family of products and aligns the taxonomy with the new direction taken in the Firefox Family project.


#### **B.** Go to Dedicated Page
