#### Greetings!

Last month I told you about a book I found this summer — "I Am A Church Member" by Thom S. Rainer. This book has opened my eyes a lot as to what it means to be a member of the Body of Christ which is called the Church. In chapter 1, we learned what it means to be a "Functioning" church member - - this month we will learn what it means to be a "UNIFYING" church member. God desires for Christians to get along - - in fact, Jesus was emphatic about it: "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35).

When we become Christians, God expects us to be part of his church. But when we become part of his church, he expects us to become a unifying presence there. **UNITY** is vital to the health of any church, and that means every church member, you and I included, must contribute to the unity of the church. We all have responsibilities as members of the church - - to be a source of unity, and never to be a divisive force. That does NOT mean that everyone always agrees with everything, all the time. But it does mean that sometimes we have to give up our preferences to keep unity in the church.

Finally, in this chapter Rainer says that unity in the church will not happen if members have what he calls "unforgiving hearts." Colossians 3:12-14 says: "Therefore, God's chosen ones, holy and loved, put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, accepting one another and forgiving one another of anyone has a complaint against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also forgive." Too many times members have anger and hurt because of something another member has said or done. Sometimes members get angry at the pastor or staff because of something they said or did or failed to do. Each church is made up of imperfect members and imperfect pastors. We will all make mistakes. We will all sin. And yes, we all are sometimes hypocrites. But church unity is torn apart when members refuse to forgive, or when any member is too prideful to grant forgiveness.

Remember to join us later this month, on **Tuesday, November 26<sup>th</sup>, for the Adel Community Thanksgiving Supper & Worship – 6:00 PM at the United Methodist Church.** And hey, I hope you read this entire newsletter carefully and keep it for future reference. It has all the preliminary information for the upcoming Advent events and worship opportunities. Let's all work together to make this Advent season 2014 the best one ever! In a spirit of UNITY, let us welcome the coming, once again of our Lord Jesus into the world! Maranatha! Come, Lord Jesus!
