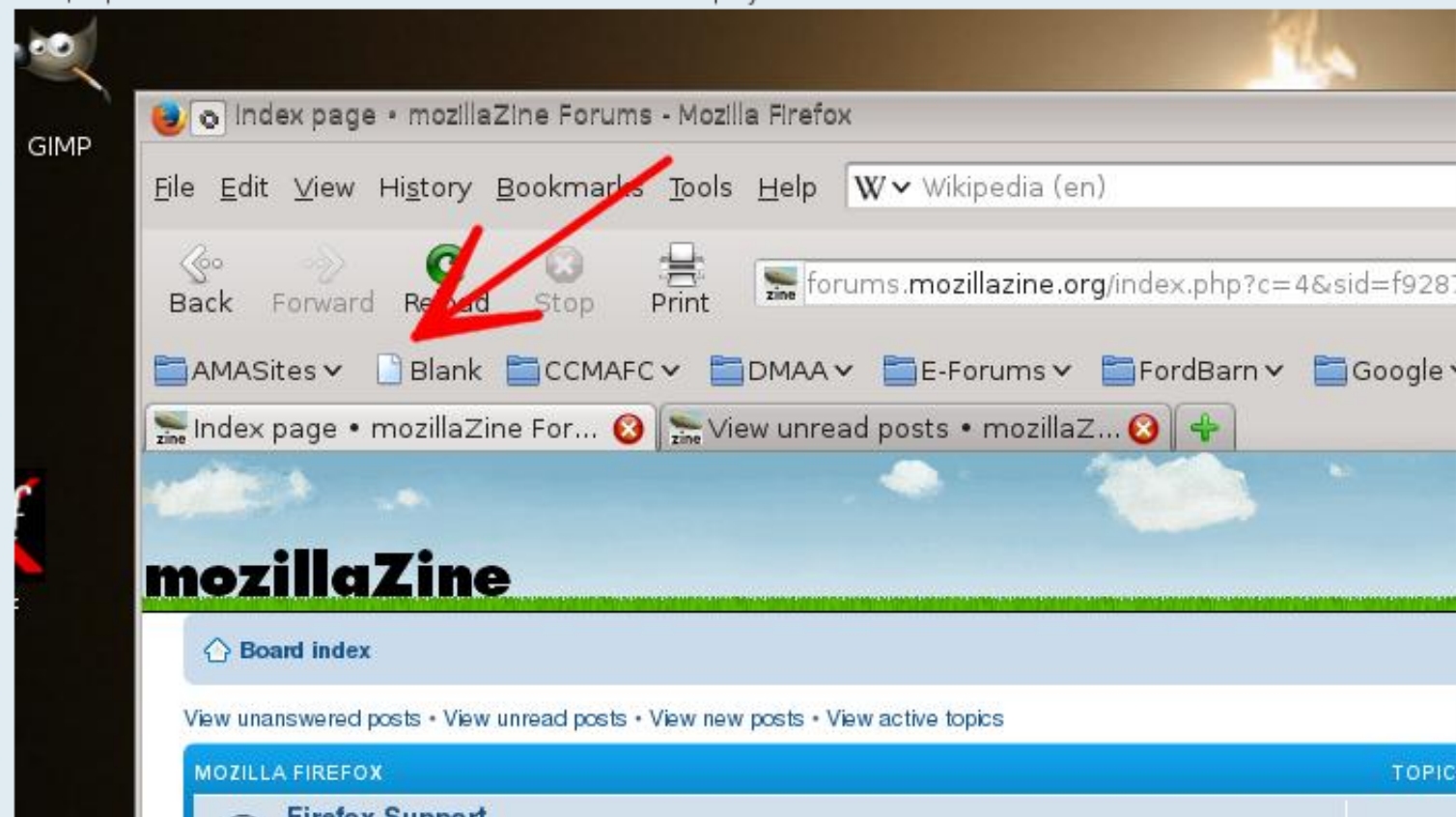


I have a bookmark on my "Bookmarks Toolbar" that has the url "about:blank". I use it when I am finished viewing a page and wish to blank the browser window. The toolbar favicon is a "blank page" icon (or something).



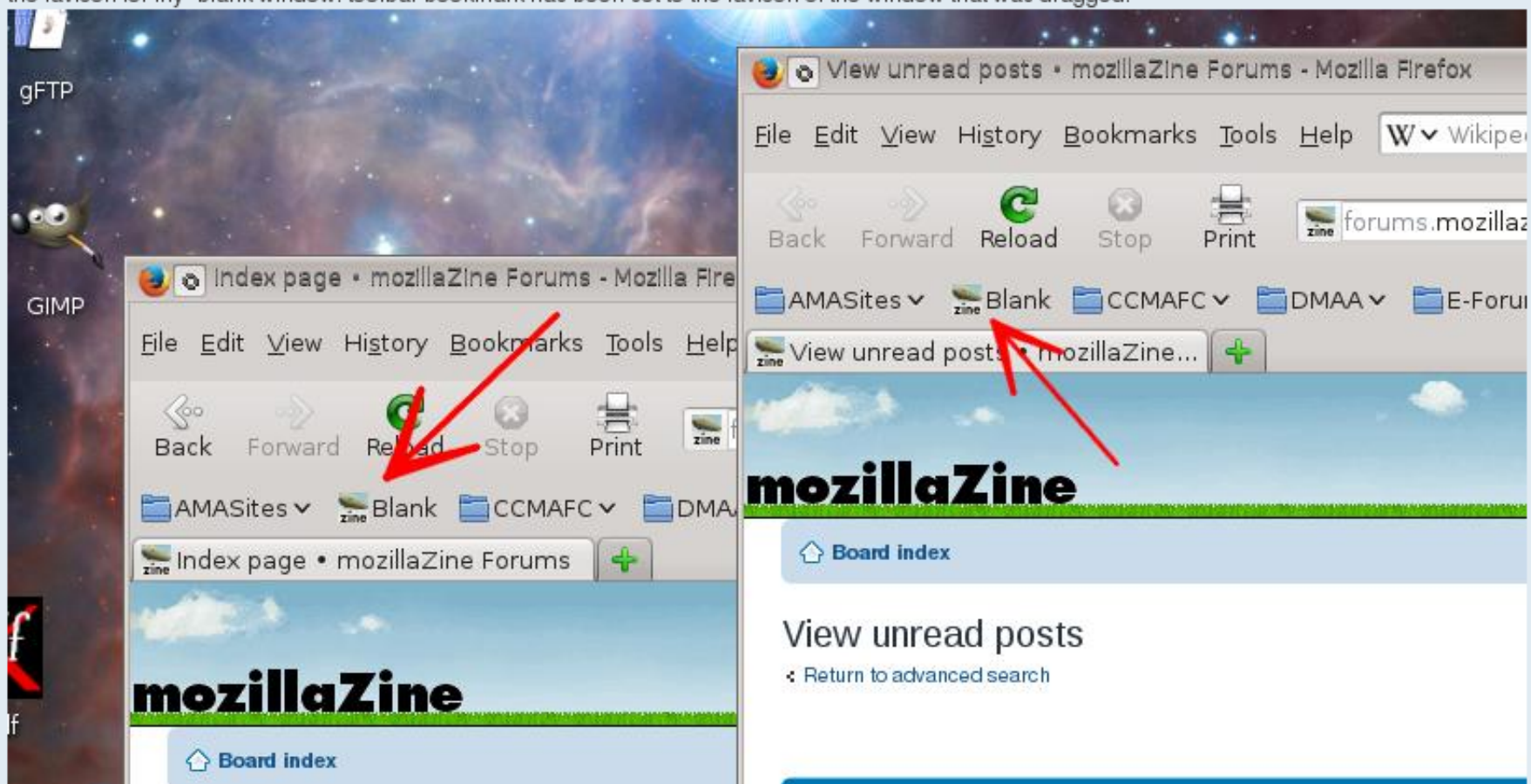
Note that the favicon is a "blank page" in the toolbar. Also note the favicon in the tab.

Now, I open a second tab. Both tabs have the same favicon displayed:



Again, note that the favicon on the toolbar is still a "blank page".

Now I drag the second tab off into the root window in order to have it in a second FF window instead of a tab in the first window. Note that as soon as this is done, the favicon for my "blank window: toolbar bookmark has been set to the favicon of the window that was dragged.



From that point on, the favicon for the toolbar bookmark will remain whatever it was changed to, until I determine what the actual favicon is and delete that favicon from the SQLite database.

Obviously, this is incorrect behavior. Anybody have any ideas on how to get it fixed? File a bug report?
