## Firefox OS Hardware Requirements

Below are the minimum requirements for a Firefox OS device. You'll notice these are more strict than B2G. We at Mozilla believe this is the necessary minimum for a great experience with Firefox OS and Firefox Marketplace applications.

CPU	1GHz, single-core, equivalent to ARM Cortex A7 processor
Storage	General purpose Device: Minimum 512 on-board Mobile phone: total storage 4GB, minimum on-board 512MB
System RAM	128MB
Visual Display (optional)	262K color, HVGA (480x320) capacitive multi-touch display (minimum two points)
GPU	WebGL-capable GPU capable of rendering H.264 video at 30FPS
Hardware Buttons	Home Power Volume Up Volume Down
	Back, Menu, and Search hardware buttons may NOT be present on a Firefox OS Co-Branded Device
