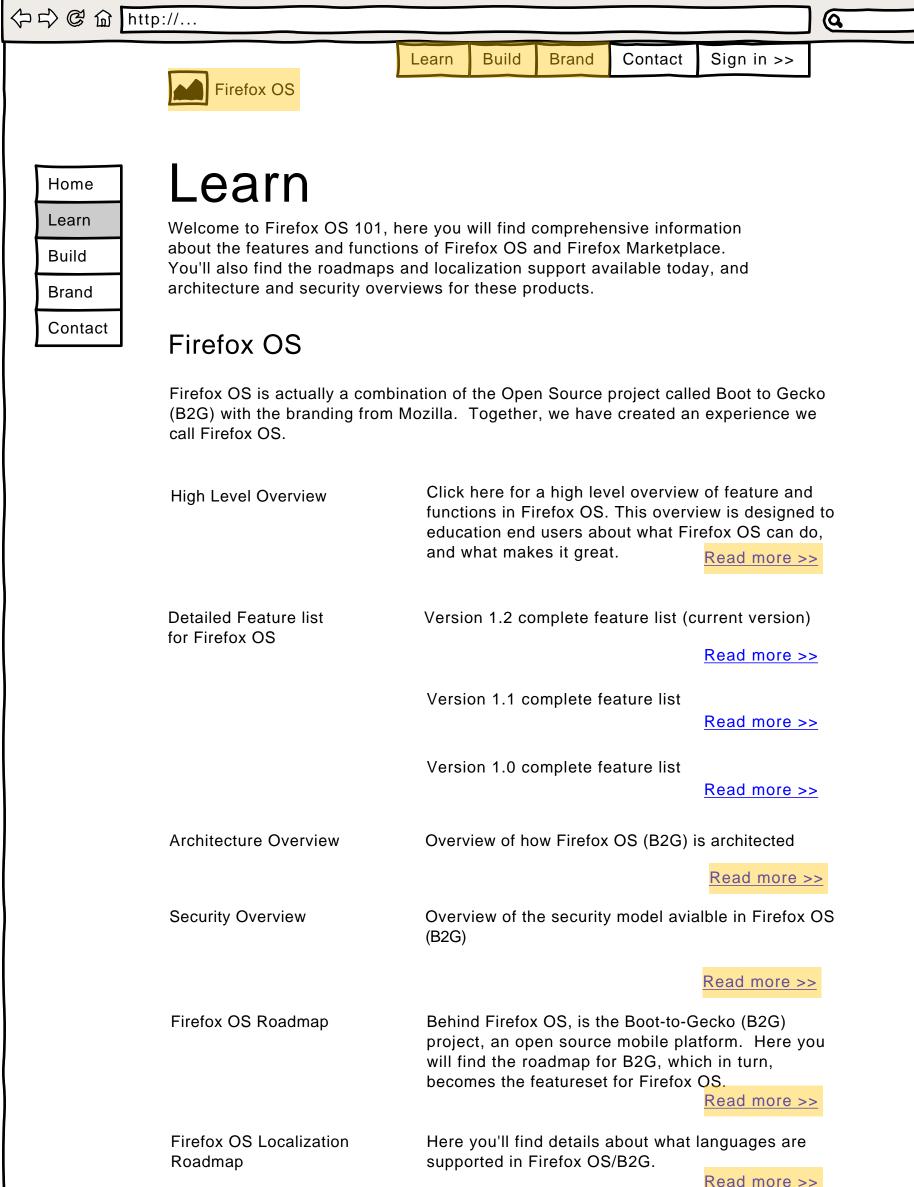

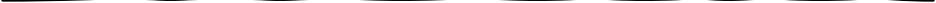

Firefox OS Hardware Requirements

Below are the minimum requirements for a Firefox OS device. You'll notice these are more strict that B2G. We at Mozilla believe this is the necessary minimum for a great experience with Firefox OS and Firefox Marketplace applications.

Visual Display (optional)	262K color,HVGA (480x320) capacitive multi-touch display (minimum two points)
GPU	WebGL-capable GPU capable of rendering H.264 video at 30FPS
Hardware Buttons	Home Power Volume Up Volume Down Back,Menu, and Search hardware buttons may NOT be present on a Firefox OS Co-Branded Device
