

## Example-File

### Summary:

Dots (.) used in form field names (here: Text Box and Formatted Field) will be converted to underscores (\_) if exported to PDF with forms.

### Description:

If you enter a form field name (for a Text Box or Formatted Field) containing dots, they will be converted to underscores (\_) if you export the document to a form-enabled PDF file. Nevertheless the saved (and loaded) ODT contains still the dots.

For example, you can enter „form.field.test“ as a Text Box name and this will result in „form\_field\_test“ in the resulting PDF (see attached examples, you need to view the PDF in a Hex-Editor if you don't own a PDF reader capable of displaying form names).

It is not important which „Submit format“ is selected in the PDF-export dialogue.

The bug was found in OO 3.1.0, 3.1.1 and 3.2.0 – it also may be there in earlier versions.

If this is not an error but an intended feature it would be nice, if the user can switch of this forced conversion if needed.

Example (Text Box name „form.field.test“ will be converted to „form\_field\_test“ in exported PDF):
