



**When tried to replicate the bug for horizontal merge:**

Note: C1 is selected.

***Inconsistent within the product:*** Vertical merge & Horizontal merge behave differently when selected.

*Vertically merged cell is handled as the upper cell (of the hidden cell).*

*Horizontally merged cell is handled as the right cell (of the hidden cell).*

*Left – Up or Right – Down is expected.*
