

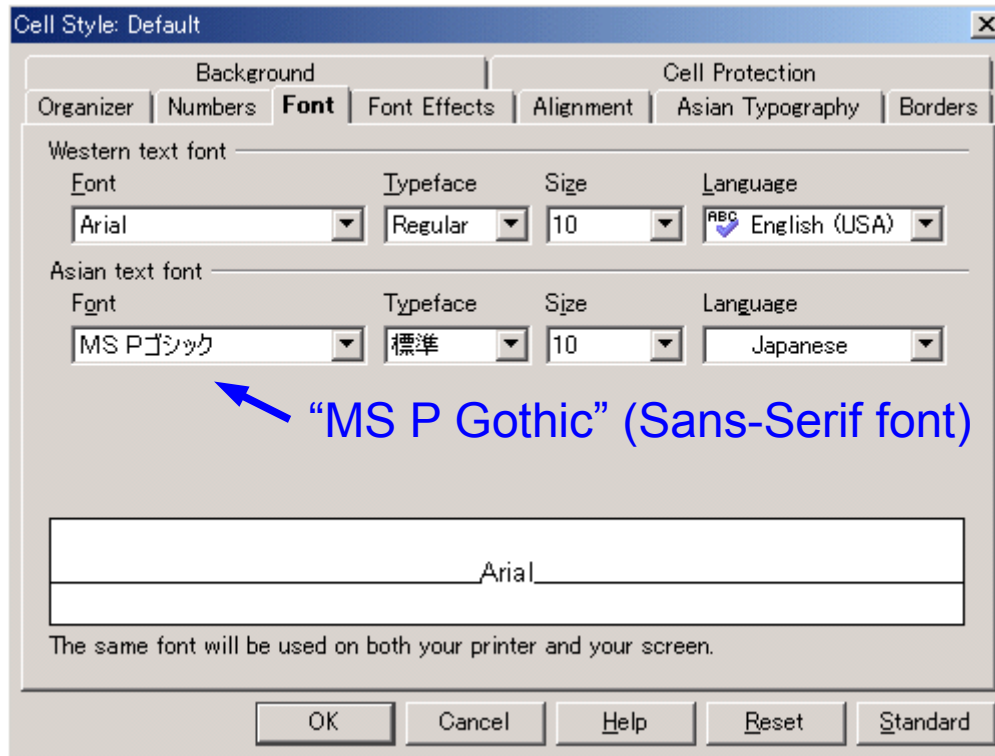
Troubles with Asian fonts in the calc chart

In this article, there are two problems described.
The latter is more serious.

- The default font for Calc charts ignore the default settings for normal cells.

- **Can't change the Asian fonts in Calc carts.**

Default setting and cells

- Fonts for “default” setting is Sans-Serif.



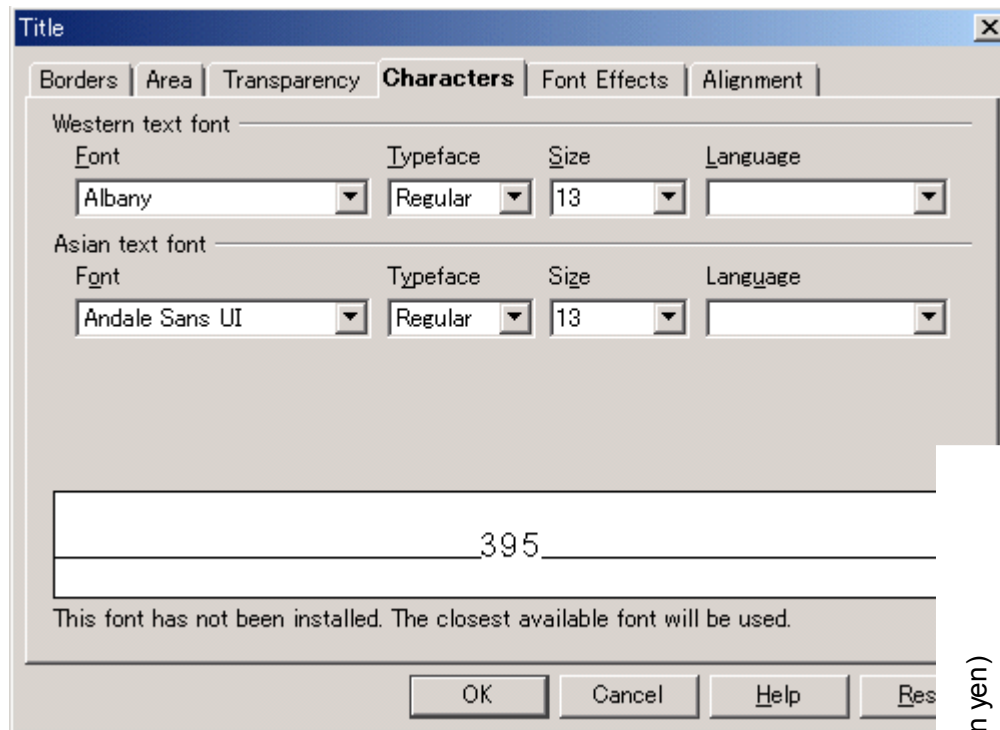
Example

Normal cells looks properly.

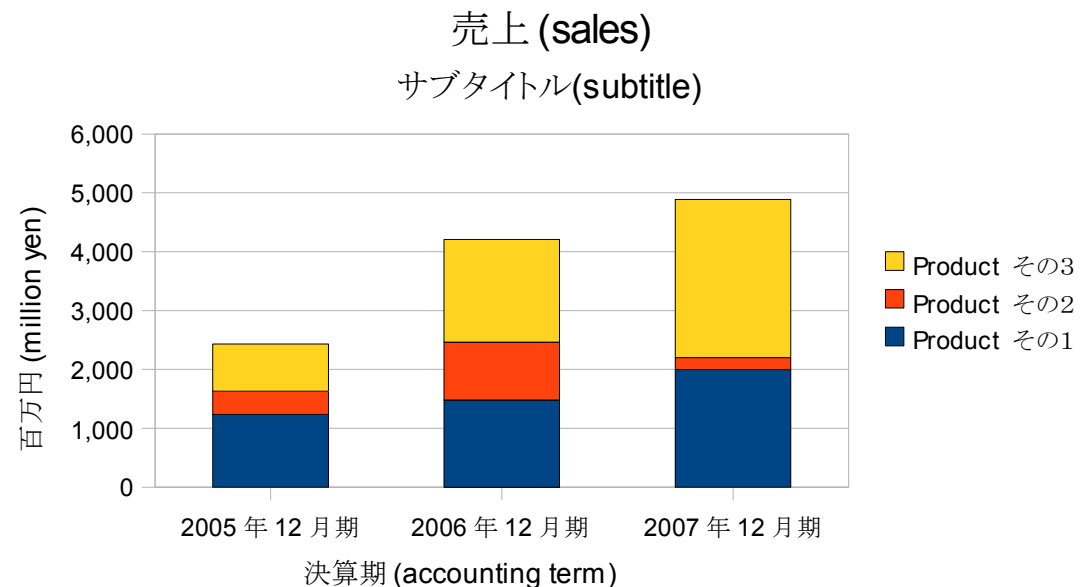
Default setting and charts

- Once you make a chart, fonts are strange.



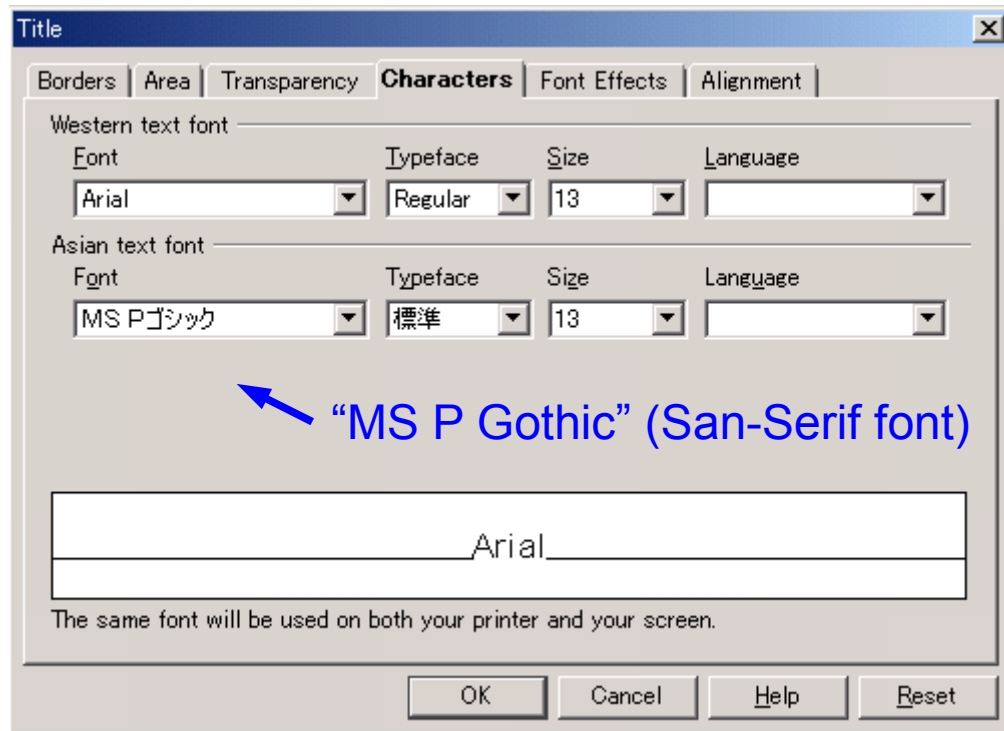
This problem has been reported as [issue 82456](#) and [issue 85934](#).

- This is the property of “Title” of the chart.
- I don't have “Albany” nor “Andale Sans UI”.
- Additionally, Language settings have gone.



Changing the fonts, but...

- After changing the fonts for the “Title”, I still see the same view.



It seems nothing has changed. Japanese characters should appear with Sans-Serif font, but they don't.

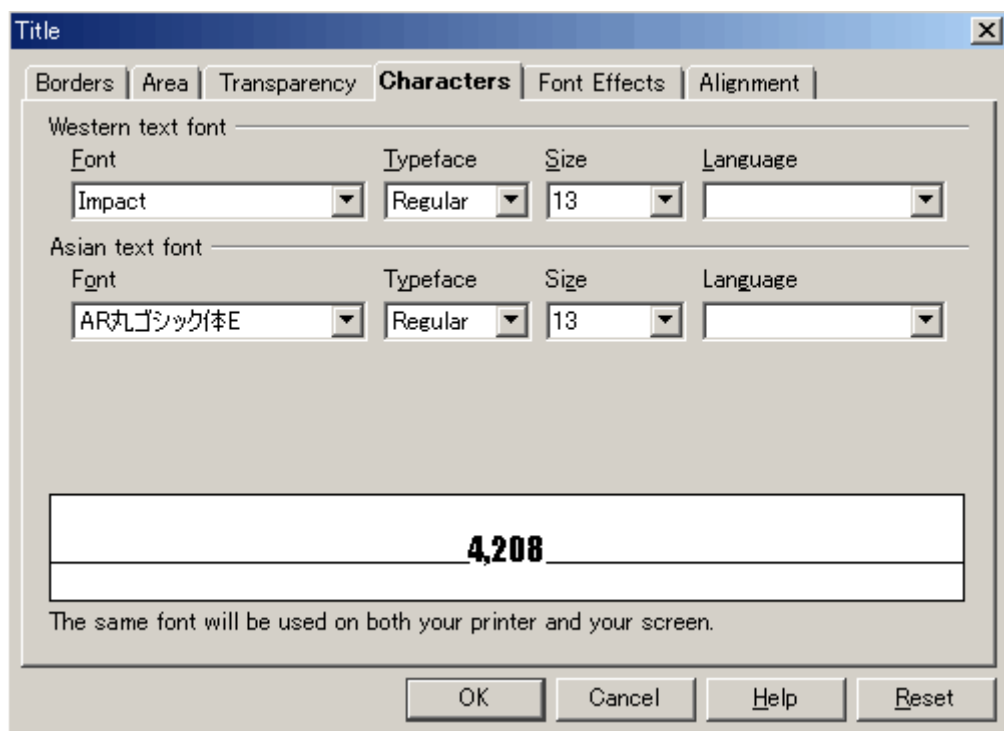

Changing the fonts again

- It seems I have no way to change the looks for Asian fonts...



It seems only the Western text font affects.
With this setting, the title should look like
this! →
