Exporting

- To export to ASP, in a OpenOffice.org Impress document choose File Export. You then see the Export dialog in which you select HTML Document as the file type. Once you have selected a directory and entered a file name (click Save. For export as ASP, we recommend selecting a "secret" file name for the HTML file (see below for more details). You then see the HTML Export dialog. Several files will be written to the directory you have just selected.
- The presenter uses the entered file name to change between the slides viewed by the audience. You can
 save the WebCast files locally or save them directly to an HTTP server. You can later transfer locally saved
 files to the HTTP server by FTP. Note that WebCast only works if the files are requested over an HTTP server.
