

## TEST CASE

- This first line is made into a list by using the bulleted list icon (bullet on/off), I am adding extra text to get to the end of the line.
- We can see that both lines are bullet listed correctly, and that the ruler above signals correctly what it should for a bullet list (first line marker is to the left of continuation line marker).
  - This second group line is made into a list by using the bulleted list icon (bullet on/off), then it is indented by clicking in the Increase-indent icon
  - As you can see, the alignment of the bulleted list is lost, the continuation of each bulleted sentence starts under the bullet, and not where it should start, in the same place as the beginning of the line.
  - Looking at the ruler above the text, we see that now the start of first line and start of second line are in the same place, while for bulleted text the first-line marker should be before the second line marker.
  - Expected behavior would have indented the text without changing the relationship between the first line marker and the second line marker, they would both have advanced the same amount.
