


# Design Tenets

Three design tenets will guide the design of MyNIAID


## Scannable

Each view of MyNIAID should be scannable so that the user can quickly ascertain what the most important information on the page is.




## Responsive

We are designing with responsiveness in mind, so that MyNIAID can be used seamlessly across devices.





## **Quick Actions**

# MyNIAID — Web View





### Web - MyNIAID - Compliance

NIAID-WF-352

#### User has clicked on Compliance filter.

#### **USER NAM**

User's name appears. On click, menu opens up for user to go to Subscriptions and Important Contacts.


#### **FILTER BEHAVIOR**

By default, all types, sources, and priorities are displayed. A user can choose to filter the list of items by clicking on a row within each facet. When a user clicks on a row to filter by, the row is highlighted. The user can only choose one within each bucket.

When filtering by type, the label updates to indicate the number and type of items that are being displayed.

The number next to the un-selected filter is removed, since none of those items are being displayed.


The numbers in adjacent facets are updated once a filter has been chosen.




## Web - MyNIAID - Snoozed -



## Web - MyNIAID - All Active - Sort Menu NIAID-WF-355

User has clicks on the Sort By menu and reveals their options for sorting.

#### **TYPE**

Order things should be displayed if by type:

• Type - Compliance, Notifications

Within each type, display in the following order:

- Due Date (closest to farthest)
- Source (alphabetical)Title (alphabetical)
- TRY IT: Click to view items sorted by priority

#### SOURCE

If user sorts by source, items appear alphabetical order by source. If there are multiple items from a single source, the items should be sorted in following order:

- Type (Compliance, Notifications)
- Due Date (closest to farthest)
- Title (alphabetical)


#### **DUE DATE**

`If user sorts by priority, items are displayed in the following order:

- Overdue
- Due Soon
- Upcoming
- Not Provided

If there are multiple items for a due date, the items should then be sorted by:

- Type (Compliance, Notifications)
- Source (alphabetical)
- Title (alphabetical)





# Web - MyNIAID - All Active - Filtered by Due Date

NIAID-WF-357

User has filtered items by due date.

#### **ITEM COUNT**

If user filters by due date or source, the item count updates to show X of X items are displayed.


#### **ADJACENT FACETS**

When a user filters in one facet, the counts in the other facets update. A user can filter across multiple facets at the same time (e.g. filter by type AND due date).

TRY IT: Click to add filters back in


#### **DEFAULT**


By default, all items within a filter type are displayed.



#### **FILTER SELECTED**

When user selects a facet, the state changes to indicate the facet that is selected. The facets that were not selected change state to indicate that they are not being displayed. The numbers should be displayed whether the facet is active or not. User can only select one at a time. If there are zero items in a facet, the item should be displayed with a 0 next to it.





# Web - MyNIAID - All Active - Add Snooze - Selecting NIAID-WF-358

User clicked on snooze icon.


#### SNOOZE OPTIONS

User chooses a date to snooze until from a date picker. Important states:

- Dates in past Not selectable
- Dates in future Selectable
- Selected Date should be highlighted

User clicks arrows to move across months.

TRY IT: Click to snooze item until next week



## Web - MyNIAID -All Active -Add Snooze - Snoozed Undo

NIAID-WF-359

User snoozed an item.

#### **NUMBER OF ITEMS**

After snoozing an item, the active items number is updated to reflect that an item has been snoozed. A number also appears next to the Snoozed tab item.

TRY IT: Click to dismiss message prior to it disappearing by itself

TRY IT: Click to undo snooze

#### SNOOZE MESSAGE


After a user chooses how long they want to snooze, the item disappears and a message appears in its place. The snoozed message indicates the date (e.g. Mar 13) that the item will be snoozed until.

#### **UNDO**

On click, undo removes the message and the item that was snoozed reappears in the Active list.

#### **CLOSE**


On click, close dismisses the message. The item remains in the Snoozed tab. If the user does not dismiss the message after 3 seconds, it will automatically disappear.



#### **EDIT SNOOZE & UNSNOOZE**



#### **UN-SNOOZE MESSAGE**


If the user dismisses the snooze, the snooze disappears from the Snoozed tab and moves to the Active tab. In its place, a message appears.

#### **UNDO UN-SNOOZE**

On click of UNDO, the item that was un-snoozed is added back to the Snoozed list.


#### **CLOSE**

The user can close the message. If the user does not close the message, it disappears after 3 seconds.

#### **UPDATED ITEM NUMBERS**

#### **DISMISS MESSAGE**

If the user dismisses an item, a message is displayed that indicates that the action was taken.

#### **UNDO UN-SNOOZE**


On click of UNDO, the item that was dismissed is added back to the

The user can close the message. If the user does not close the message, it disappears after 3 seconds.


