

- Do not use BEVESPI AEROSPHERE more often than prescribed
- Do not take BEVESPI AEROSPHERE with other medicines that contain a LABA. Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take
- Tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions including heart problems, thyroid problems, diabetes, liver problems, glaucoma, prostate or bladder problems

**BEVESPI AEROSPHERE can cause serious side effects, including:**

- Sudden breathing problems immediately after inhaling your medicine
- Serious allergic reactions. Call your healthcare provider or get emergency medical help if you have symptoms of a serious allergic reaction: rash; hives; swelling of the face, mouth, or throat
- Fast or irregular heartbeat, increased blood pressure, chest pain
- Tremor or nervousness
- New or worsened eye problems, including acute narrow-angle glaucoma. Symptoms may include eye pain, nausea or vomiting, blurred vision, seeing halos or bright colors around lights, and changes in vision. Call your healthcare provider right away before taking another dose
- New or worsened urinary retention. Symptoms may include difficulty urinating, or urinating in a weak stream or drips. If you have any of these symptoms, stop taking BEVESPI AEROSPHERE and call your healthcare provider right away
- High blood sugar or low blood potassium


Common side effects of BEVESPI AEROSPHERE include urinary tract infection and constipation. Tell your healthcare provider about any side effect that bothers you or that does not go away.

## APPROVED USE


BEVESPI AEROSPHERE is a prescription medicine used to treat chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). COPD includes chronic bronchitis, emphysema, or both. BEVESPI AEROSPHERE is used in the morning and in the evening, to improve symptoms of COPD for better breathing. BEVESPI AEROSPHERE is not used to treat sudden symptoms of COPD; it won't replace a rescue inhaler. BEVESPI AEROSPHERE is not used to treat asthma.
