From the Red Hat Bugzilla (https://bugzilla.redhat.com/show_bug.cgi?id=384711):

When using "save link as" or "save page as", the GNOME file save dialog appears, and it lets the user enter URLs for non-local folders in the "Name" box - it even does suggestion and completion on such urls where possible (for example when using an ssh:// url to a host that has private key authentication), but when entering a full url for such non-local folders, including target filename and pressing enter, the dialog is dismissed without an error but no file is actually created at the target. Doing the same for local folders (typing the entire path and file name at the "Name" box) works.

Reproducible: Always

Steps to Reproduce:

1. open firefox and go to some web page
2. select "File" -> "Save page as..."
3. In the name box type a non-local url including file name, for example smb://someserver/someshare/somefile or even trash:///somefile and click on the "Save" button.
