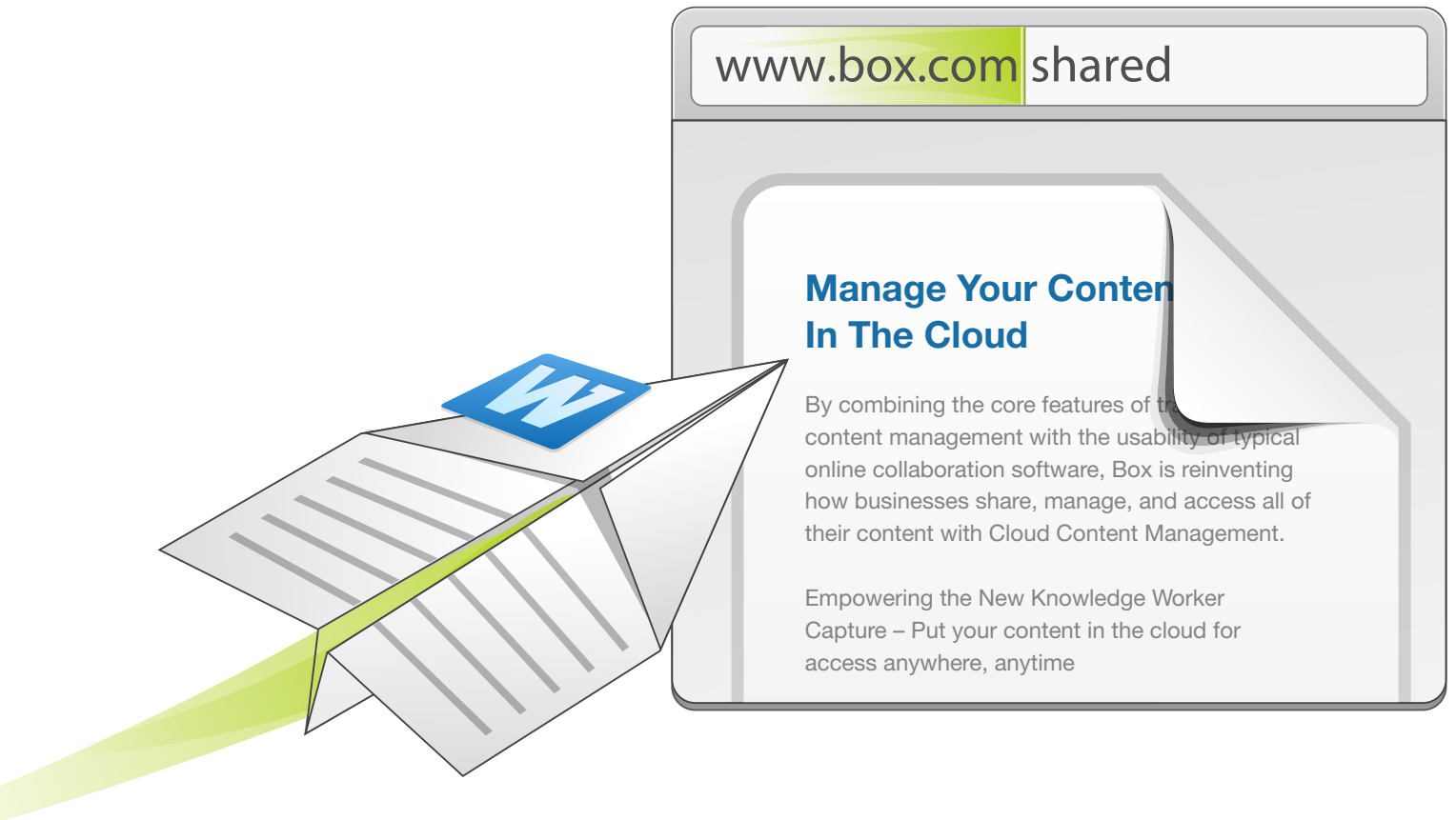

## Send a link


Paste it into an email or an instant message, even send directly from Box.

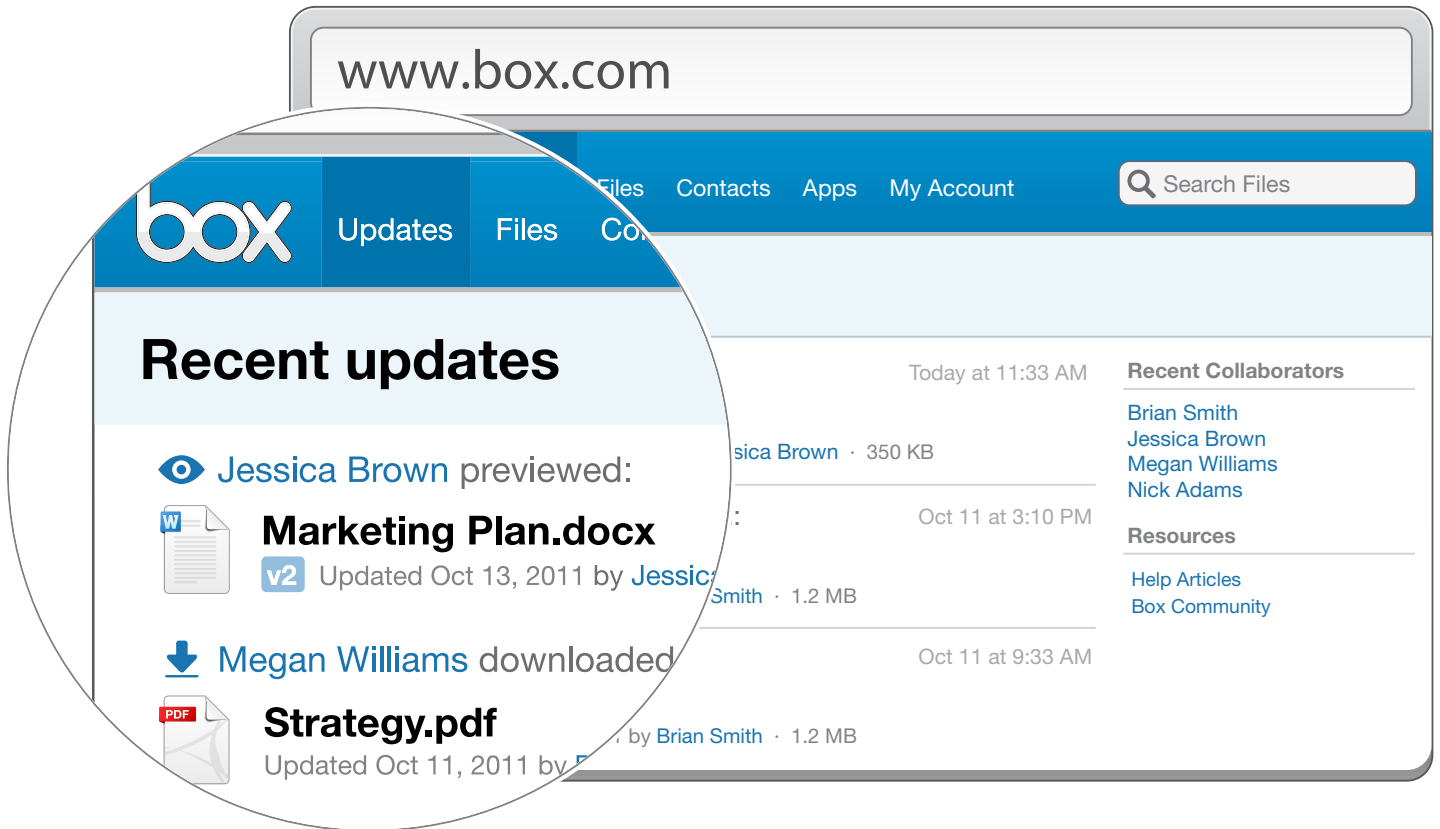
