2 progress reports shall be grounds for noticing the case for
3 conversion to a case under Chapter 7 or dismissal under Section
4 1112(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. Section 1112(b); and it is
5 further

6 ORDERED that the debtor be, and it hereby is, directed to carry
7 out the Plan as modified hereby and to comply with any orders of
8 this Court; and it is further


9 ORDERED that, as provided by Section 1141(d) of the Bankruptcy
10 Code, 11 U.S.C. Section 1141(d), the debtor be, and it hereby is,
11 discharged from any debt arising prior to the date of entry of this
12 Order, excepting administrative expenses under Section 503(b) of the
13 Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. Section 503(b), and that the debtor be,
14 and it hereby is, granted such further and supplemental relief as is
15 set forth in the Plan as modified hereby; and it is further

16 ORDERED that this Court retains jurisdiction herein to make
17 from time to time, all orders necessary and proper to administer
18 this case until and after consummation of the Plan as provided in
19 the Plan and the Disclosure Statement.


