Terry and Vivian Flanagan founded the Ryan Patrick winery in 1996, naming it after their two sons, Ryan and Patrick. They planted some of the first wine grapes in what is now Washington State's newest American Viticultural Area (AVA), Ancient Lakes of Columbia Valley. Named after the 35 lakes that dot the area, the state's thirteenth AVA runs along a stretch of steep cliffs above the Columbia River and surrounds the town of Quincy, Washington.



2019 SAUVIGNON BLANC

This Sauvignon Blanc has floral aromas with some citrus, peach and nectarine flavors. Very, very slight grassy notes and herbaciousness. All with a crisp, dry mouth-feel.

2019 NAKED CHARDONNAY

Scents of apple and pear, with some honeydew melon; citrus and floral notes. Refreshing, yet savory entry with a fresh fruit driven mid-palate and an elegant, pleasing finish.

2018 REDHEAD RED BLEND

Black cherry and ripe raspberry with dark chocolate, savory herb, and red currant on the nose. A juicy entry with a plush mid-palate, and a long fruit driven finish.

2018 ROCK ISLAND CHARDONNAY

Stone fruit notes with peach and honeydew melon, with scents of fresh bread dough, crème brûlée, and vanilla. Nice, rich and round mouthfeel. Peach, Nectarine, toasted bread, and vanilla on the palate.

Dark cherry and rich plum with hints of lavender, dried herbs, anise, and cocoa. A generous juicy entry, with a jammy mid-palate and pleasurable silky finish.
