Then we head back to Main Beach and watch a group of tourists learning to surf.

11AM We arrive at the colourful, open-air Village Markets (held on the first and third Sunday of the month) in the grounds of the Burleigh Heads State School. The markets were set up by two local girls Sarah Schoeller and Mariasa Bowden, and have become a platform for local designers, artists and vintage buffs to showcase their wares. We browse the stalls selling vintage fashion and collectibles, homemade cashmere, home wares and other second-hand treasures while enjoying the morning sunshine.

1.30PM We make one last pit stop at Vintage Espresso at Mermaid Beach, continuing on the day's retro theme, for a fresh fruit salad with yoghurt and one last latte served in the café's eclectic interior — having thoroughly enjoyed discovering a new side to the Gold Coast. ★

GO FOR GOLD

Head north for a glamorous girls' weekend on the Gold Coast

Like me, your perceptions of the Gold Coast might be that it's glitzy and gaudy. To have this view confirmed, you need only take a late-night stroll along the nightclub strip of Orchid Avenue in Surfers Paradise, where girls in skin-tight handbag dresses totter on impossibly high heels and heavy-set bouncers guard nightclub doorways. But the Gold Coast is much more than Surfers; look closer and you'll find a new wave of young people attempting to alter their hometown's low-brow image. That's why, believe it or not, the Gold Coast ticks all the right boxes for a glam girls' weekend away.

FRIDAY

4.30PM Having taken the afternoon off work, it's hang on 4.30pm when we land at Coolangatta Airport, and within 30 minutes we've checked into the Vibe Hotel Surfers Paradise. We drink in the heavenly ocean, hinterland and Nerang River views from our 22nd floor room, then kick back at the downstairs Dilah with a cocktail or two.

6.30PM We tuck into an early dinner of Barramundi fillet in a steaming coconut broth with Asian vegetables at the funky hotel bar, before heading for the Arts Centre at Bundall, the Gold Coast's leading cultural facility, to take in a French film and glass of wine. It's late when we turn in; but before I do, I step out on to the balcony once more to look out at the twinkling city lights and listen to the waves crashing on Main Beach.
