Brief Project Description: The proposed project would renovate the existing single-screen movie theater facility (Crest Theater) located at 1262 Westwood Blvd, Los Angeles, CA to create a live performance venue for use by the UCLA School of Arts and Architecture (to be renamed Nimoy Theater). The scope of work would include upgrades to bring the building into compliance with code and seismic safety standards; interior improvements to the auditorium, back-of-house spaces, lobby, and event spaces; and refresh of exterior finishes, including updated signage to reflect the new name of the venue. Due to the historic significance of the building, all improvements would be completed in conformance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Treatment of Historic Resources, under the oversight of a qualified preservation consultant to ensure that the improvements would be completed in a manner that would not compromise the building's historic integrity.

Determination: Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee.
