Classroom work will be accepted in the regular monthly shows at the gallery, but will not be allowed at the Annual Open Juried Show. The integrity of the art work is the responsibility of the artist. Enter up to 3 pieces - \$18 each piece for members; \$25 each piece for non-members. Maximum diagonal measurement for the combined entries is 110 inches.




"How To Prepare a Digital Image of Your Art" by Larry Vogel Friday, August 17, 2018, 1:30PM-3:30PM
