In the case of premises covering an area of more than 50 METRES SQUARE, a further Notice in the same form must be displayed EVERY 50 METRES along the exterior of the premises abutting any highway.

The Notice must be displayed for a period of NO LESS THAN 28 CONSECUTIVE DAYS starting on the day after the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority (East Riding Of Yorkshire Council).

Representations by a Responsible Authority or an Relevant Person must be made in writing during a period of 28 consecutive days starting on the day after the day on which the application is given to the Licensing Authority.
