What The Bobby Van Trust Does:

The Bobby Van Trust sends out Bobby Operators to people's homes to give expert advice on safety in their home and installs equipment to improve the home's security.

Bobby Operators are:

- Skilled carpenters/lock fitters
- Trained Crime Reduction Officers
- Trained Fire Safety Advisers.

Bobby Operators wear uniforms similar to those worn by Police Officers, for reassurance, and always carry formal identification.

Three vans, each with a dedicated Bobby Operator, are operated by the Trust across Swindon and Wiltshire.

This is a free service!

The Bobby Van Trust is entirely responsible for raising its own funds to deliver the service.

How Bobby Vans Operate:

Visits are made to the client's home - and are made only by appointment.

Operators reassure and address any concerns that the client may have.



The Bobby Operator evaluates needs by means of a security and fire risk assessment.

Bobby Vans are mobile

workshops; we supply and fit all locks and fittings necessary to secure the property – free of charge.





The client is advised on good practice regarding property security, personal safety and fire prevention.

Information is shared with other agencies which may be able to help the client.

Bobby Operators also:

- distribute Message-in-a-Bottle funded by the local Lions Club to give vital information in an emergency
- · supply carbon monoxide detectors
- supply and fit key safes with access codes stored on the Wiltshire Police database
- supply, fit and maintain CCTV safety cameras
