

The Problem

- The TA-3 parking issue is not new. It is directly associated with how far from the workplace that people park.
- It is also:
 - related to employee expectations and consequently it is probably the *number 1 issue of employees* at TA-3;
 - a growing safety and security concern.





TA-3 Parking Structures

- In response 2 parking structures have been budgeted and completed, or underway.
 - TA-3 West Parking Structure IGPP
 - TA-3 North-central Parking Structure NSSB Line
 Item
- We are now faced with a year of impact associated with construction and the shifting of the locations of available parking.






TA-3 West Parking Structure

- Opened April 12⁵
 337 parking spaces (in structure).
- By May 21 another
 80 surface spaces
 will be available after
 the contractor
 demobilizes.









Near Term Impacts

West Parking	+337 (April)
Structure	+ 80 (May)
NSSB Structure start	-280 (April)
Available by shuttle today	+145 (available prior to NSSB start, but not used)
Sub-total	282 (available – lost)







Late FY04/Early FY05 Impacts

- The LASO building construction is expected to begin in the September – October) timeframe; *loss of 240 spaces* on the West side of SM38.
- At that time, without other measures, the increases on the previous slide would be reduced to 42.



April 2005

- NSSB parking opens approximately 675 spaces.
- Security Perimeter Project will remove parking in the Gateway but will replace parking first with little reduction in total spaces.

Very positive increases of available spaces over this 04/05 time-frame




What else can be done?

- Assure effective use of shuttle (coordinated with park & ride; timely pickup schedules; etc.)
- Pave/open more surface lots such as in the "Gateway" area.
- The following slides notes other areas being considered.

Communication must continue to be ahead of impact to employees.
