VIOLATORS' FINES SWELL GAME PROPAGATION FUND

The State fund for game propagation in Maryland was increased by \$450 on November 10 when three illegal duck hunters paid fines of \$150 each, reports the U. S. Biological Survey.

The three violators--J. Herbert Ewell, of Chester, Pa., and Carl Myers and Charles W. Myers, of Quarryville, Pa.--were apprehended on November 6 by a Federal deputy game management agent and a State game warden. Charged with hunting wild ducks from a motorboat, in closed season, and on Sunday, they pleaded guilty before Justice of the Peace J. Howard Pugh, of Port Deposit, Md.
