

#### Who can help?

Almost anyone! We are seeking people of all ages, from youth groups to retired professionals. We have challenges and tasks for any age group, working on a range of projects which include: helping wildlife, improving recreation sites, gathering archaeological information and more. You can work alone or come with a group. Assignments vary in scope and duration and volunteers are not limited by age, only their willingness to serve. Whatever your interest, there's a volunteer opportunity to match. What a great chance for families to come together with a purpose.

#### What can I do to help?

Volunteer opportunities are diverse — a volunteer may be working with a wildlife biologist monitoring nesting habits of raptors. There may be opportunities to assist archaeologists discover and protect sites. Groups can assist in preserving and replanting stream vegetation. Campground and river host volunteers meet new people and help visitors enjoy the great outdoors. Scout troops can help install information signs along some of Utah's backways and byways. Small and large crews can help install and maintain fencing, build and maintain hiking and biking trails, construct and refurbish camp areas, and improve wildlife habitat. Utah is a state known for its diverse lands, the opportunities to serve are as diverse.
